



PAINTING SKIES

Q: A reader asks: Can you give me some tips for painting skies.

A: Skies are not difficult if you follow these basic rules. Use a large brush to apply paint quickly. Skies are best painted wet-in-wet.


Wet the paper by applying an initial wash of a weak raw sienna. The timing is important. The initial wash must not be allowed to become more than one third dry before painting in the cloud shapes or hard edges

will occur on drying.

Use a light touch with the brush and the minimum of brush strokes to ensure freshness in the painting.

Use an absorbent tissue to control edges and to remove excess paint if required to create white cloud formations.

Government to allow BGGER house extensions.



Homeowners will be allowed to build extensions of up to eight metres for detached homes and six metres for other properties, as the government now looks to get planning officers 'off people's backs'.

It's not just homes that will be allowed to extend further, as shop and office owners will also be allowed to expand the boundaries of their premises. Businesses would be able to expand shops by 100 square metres and industrial units by 200 square metres.

David Cameron the Prime minister said the new changes would help 'cut through the bureaucracy' that is currently holding the UK economy back in a vice.

However, the Local Government Association has described the claims that planning permission is holding back home building as a 'myth'. It is set to release figures which show that around 400,000 prospective homes have been given planning permission but are yet to be built.

The PM David Cameron and Deputy PM Nick Clegg have announced that 16,500 first-time buyers are to receive help getting on the housing ladder under an extension of the FirstBuy scheme.

Without a deposit would-be homeowners would be given an equity loan of up to 20% of the purchase price.

Are these changes permanent?


NO. They will be for a fixed time period only which has yet to be announced.



This is a very enjoyable ramble taking you along quiet lanes and beautiful villages. To start the walk, leave the village street and turn left into Puddington Lane, which is adjacent the church. After 10 minutes walk along this road you will reach a point where the road bears

left. Leave the road here and continue ahead over a cattle-grid leading to a farm road. This path, a short cut to Puddington, leads to a step-stile on the left of a farm gate. Cross over the stile and go forward through a narrow passage-way, this leads you to the entrance of Puddington Old Hall. Puddington Old Hall was once home to the Masseys, a family who for several centuries held the manor of "Potintone" or "Podynton". The house

was once surrounded by a deep moat and accessed by a drawbridge up until 70 years ago.

From the Hall turn left for a short distance, past the left of the village green and look ahead for a signpost directing to Chester-Parkgate Road. Head along the tranguil by-way, Piper's Lane, for 15 minutes, unitl you come across white gates on either side of the lane. 50 vards after this the lane ends at acrossing gate. Here you will look to the right of this gate for an entrance to a path between bushes. Continue ahead through the trees as the track bears left until you reach a two bar stile. The way is forward, with a pond and Manor House Farm on your right, to arrive at a tall hedge. Cross this by means of a six step iron ladder stile and into the next field. Here go around the small wood on your left and go straight across to a wooden foot bridge. This leads you into the last field where you follow the left hedge, you soon reach a gate, beyound which is the Chester High Road.

Go across, bearing slightly to the left, into Badger's Rake Lane. Here continue along a lovely lane until the road bears left, passing "Inglewood" and then turns sharply to the right. Go straight ahead along a wide farm road

passing Oaks Farm until coming meeting a crossing lane. Here turn left, after 5 minutes walk the lane brings you to a track leading from a bridge over the Wirral Way. Descend and turn left into the Way and follow the path for half a mile. When you see a gate ahead, leave the Way and go through a gap at the side of the gate. Here, a narrow path leads you to Smithy Lane. At the foot of this lane, turn right along Hadlow Road until you reach an opening for Pollard's Inn. Pollards is a charming pub and restaurant with bedrooms, set in the stunning village of Willaston. Real ale and home cooking make this a worthy rest. On Leaving Pollards Inn, return to Hadlow Road and go forward to pass the old railway station. Here, the station master's house and the booking hall have been restored to look as it did in the 1950's. Beyond the old station, your direction is still ahead until Hadlow Road reaches Chester High Road. Where the two roads meet you will see an odd shaped stone known as the Wirral Stone. It appears to be three steps of an old mounting block from an inn door.

Cross the A540 bearing right to enter Dunstan Lane. At first, the lane passes through a quiet residential area, but opens up to countryside. After passing Mudhouse Lane, the square tower of Burton Church can be seen. The present building was erected in 1721, but a church has stood there since the early 12th century. The church is dedicated to St. Nicholas, the patron saint of mariners, a time when Burton was a busy sea port. In 1561, Burton then possessed five ale houses

and today has none.

Izumi Tabata


Tabata was founded by a Japanese scientist named Izumi Tabata and fellow colleagues at a department of physiology in Japan.

Izumi and his fellow scientists decided to conduct a study to compare moderate intensity training with high intensity training.

The end result was burning fat and increasing aerobic capacity in a much shorter time than regular training.


Tabata is high intensity training with each exercise lasting 4 minutes. Heres the concept:

20 seconds intense training 10 seconds rest repeat 8 times



Jog on the spot at a steady pace for 4 minutes to elevate the heart rate perform 4 - 5 dynamic (movement) stretches.

Apply the concept above to all of the following exercises:



Walk for 5 minutes to let the heart rate come back down then perform a static stretch for 20 seconds to each body part.

Are hybrid cars really environmentally friendly?



Answer:

It depends on how they are used. They're great for city drivers, when a hybrid can rely almost fully on it's electric motor, which is quiet, doesn't create any emmissions, will turn off completely when the car is stationary and, crucially, gives superb fuel economy.

Get driving your car on the open road and the hybrid will have to fall back on its petrol engine, because the electric motor simply doesn't have the power to drive the car at higher speeds, nor the energy to run for long distances. In such cases, the hybrid car will act just like a comparable conventional petrol driven car, and offer the same emmissions and similar fuel economy.

How can bees fly if they are too heavy?

Answer:

The idea that bees should not be able to fly has been around since the early 30's when scientists tried to calculate the bees body mass against its wing size and the amount of lift needed to generate flying. High spped technology today allows scientist to see that the bee's ability to fly comes from a very complex way they flap their wings. The bees wings do not flap up and down, but the root of the wings move forward and backwards which generate the tips of the wings to move in an oval movement. As the wings move at such high speeds this creates air currents which are then strong enough to lift the bees body weight.



How thick is my skin?


Answer:

Your skin is very thin. It is only 2 millimetres thick. On top is a layer of tough, dead cells called the epidermis. These cells gradually rub off. New cells grow underneath to replace them. Underneath is another layer called the dermis. This contains areas that give the sense of touch.

What is the most active muscle in your body

Answer:

The most active muscles in your body are your eye muscles. They contract about 100,000 times a day. Much of this movement takes place whilst you are asleep and dreaming as they flicker under your closed eyelids.



Who was the tallest & shorterst men in the world

Answer:

The tallest recorded man in the world was Robert Wadlow. He was born in 1918 and died aged only 22, measuring 272cm (8ft 11.1in). He hadn't reached his full height when he died and doctors believe he could have grown to 274cm (9ft).

The shortest ever recorded man in the world is Gel Mohammed of New Dheli, India. He was measured in 1990 and was only 75cm (22.5 in) tall.

The limits of my language are the limits of my world

Local organisation aims to increase cultural awareness

Do you speak one or more foreign languages, either privately or professionally? Evidence suggests that if the answer is no, then you could be missing out...

A recent survey of senior managers found that 61% believe not knowing the local language is the biggest obstacle in the way of successfully conducting business negotiations abroad, yet only 37% of those questioned said their company actually offered language training to their employees. "There is an image of Brits abroad - and amongst our European neighbours in particular - that we are reluctant language learners, and assume we can easily get by simply speaking English wherever we go", says Stuart Burke, founder of 'Wirral Multilingual', a new venture based in Hoylake that was set up to promote the world of cultural diversity - and opportunity - that exists on our doorstep.

Unfortunately, it seems that this rather negative stereotype is backed up by the facts... Traditional A-level disciplines such as French and German are in "freefall", following a record decline in entry rates over the last decade. According to the most recent official figures, currently about one in ten state primary schools offers no language lessons at all, and a further 20% only offer it to some year groups.

The Government has taken heed of this alarming drop in language teaching - particularly noticeable at secondary school level - and has moved to make languages a requirement from age seven, as part of a new primary National Curriculum taking effect in 2014. More than half of pupils taking GCSEs in 2013 will be doing a language, compared to 43% in 2010. "Learning another language is good for young children and it will give them more options in education and work [in later life]" said Michael Gove (Education Secretary) in June; a statement with which Stuart whole-heartedly agrees: "I have always enjoyed learning and speaking other languages, and it has certainly opened up my eyes to the rich tapestry of cultures around the world. I would encourage everybody to learn at least one foreign language, from the earliest possible age. But it is also never too late to start!" It has been proven that countries with high-performing education systems begin teaching foreign languages at a much younger age than in England. New Zealand and Singapore teach languages from age six, and Finland at age nine. In Hong Kong, English is compulsory from the start of primary school.

The aim of 'Wirral Multilingual' is to enable Wirral residents to learn a new language, improve their current language skills, or meet and chat with other nationalities. It is also expected that the service will provide Wirral-based companies with access to professional translation/interpreting services, a source of multilingual staff, and the tools to expand their business operations across Europe and beyond.
