

Keith Fenwick - Sky TV's 'ART DOCTOR'



PAINTING SNOW COVERED MOUNTAINS

A reader asks: I enjoy watching snow covered mountain scenery on the television and would love to be able to paint such scenes, unfortunately they look so complex I wouldn't know to know where to begin. Can you please advise me?

A: The painting illustrated will appear frightening to the less experienced. Think of painting the mountain structure as putting together a jigsaw, piece by piece. It is important to produce the drawing as accurate as possible.

Note the distribution of snow, the mountain structure, the colours and shadows. It is important to learn to see not


make do with a cursary glance.

My next stage was to apply masking fluid to preserve the white of the paper to represent snow.

Once the masking fluid is completely dry, apply pale washes of raw sienna/burnt umber to the whole of the mountain, over the masking. Let the washes dry fully then remove the masking fluid by rubbing with a finger to reveal the white of the paper representing a snow covered mountain. Finally some shadows were painted in to give form to the mountain range.



20 PUB WALKS TO THE AROUND WALK Red Lion Inn, Parkgate 5



Red Lion Inn circa 1920

Thornton Hough - Manior Wood - Wood Lane - Parkgate - The Wirral Way - Neston - Cherry Wood - Raby - Thornton Hough (9 miles)

In the early years of the last century, Thornton Hough, was just another Wirral village with a handful of decaying and insanitary farm-labourers' cottages. Its transformation into a model estate village was the work of two landlords. Joseph Hirst, a Yorkshire textile manufacturer, built the parish church, the vicarage and the first school and William Hesketh Lever, of "Sunlight" soap fame, rebuilt the rest of the village in a pleasant half-timbered style. Lever built, too, a new Congregational Church.

Begin the walk by going forward into the short road almost opposite the Seven Stars Inn. This road leads you into Manor Road and, after following this pleasant rural road for ten minutes or so, you reach a signpost on the left. Here you turn left, through an opening, to join a grassy path. Not far ahead, this track bears to the left and, after passing under two ornamental bridges, leads along the side of Manor Wood. At the end of this path, continue forward over a one-step stile to reach a well-trodden path which winds its way through a plantation for about half a mile. In the field which follows, bear leftwards along the edge of the field, with the railway on your right, and shortly arrive at a stile which brings you to the A540.

The way is now left for a few yards, and then cross the dual carriageway to a bachelor gate, to the right of Garden House Nurseries. Go forward across two styles very close together and, shortly after, a bridge over the railway. Keep forward to reach a two-bar stile and continue across the next field with the hedge on your right, to arrive at stone steps which bring you out into Boathouse Lane. Here you turn left and, after passing Leighton Road, you reach Wood Lane, where your direction is now to the left. Five minutes' walk along this quiet lane brings you to the entrance, on the right, to a footpath. This path leads up to a wooden footbridge and, after passing under this, keep forward until you arrive at Parkgates sea-front. Now turn left and shortly reach the Red Lion Inn.

The Red Lion, a handsome black and white pub, has remained unchanged since it was first recorded in 1822, and is the oldest of Parkgate's surviving pubs. Inside there are two lounges, a bar and a small snug. It has several Victorian, cast-iron, Britannia tables, lots of copper and brass and an

interesting picture collection also serving food.

To resume the walk, turn left as you leave the Red Lion, walk to the end of the seafront and tuen left, into Station Road. Not far ahead, on the right of the road, enter the access path to the Wirral Way and go forward, with the Dee on your right. The way passes through a built up residential area. When you reach the remains of the demolished bridge, leave the Way and turn left, along Bridge Street, for about 100 yards. Cross the road and turn right, into Station Road. Follow this road under a railway bridge and then continue forward to reach Mellock Lane. Here you go straight across, to rejoin the Wirral Way.

For the next half-mile, the sandstone sides of an impressive cutting through solid rock tower above you. When you reach Lees Lane bridge, a handsome structure of Cheshire sandstone, pass under the bridge and then turn left into Lees Lane. This lane soon brings you to the Chester High Road. Here you turn left, walk about a hundred yards, cross the road, and climb the steps in a wall to enter a field. With a wall on your left, cross the field to reach a stone step-stile leading down to Quarry Road. Now the way is to the right . Not too far ahead, on the left of the road, you will pass by a stone water tower and, shortly after, where the lane makes a right turn, you will see a lane leading off to the left. Here there are two routes open. Do not enter the lane, but look left for a bachelor gate; this is your way. Go through the gate and along a fieldpath which keeps close to the hedge on your right. This path soon brings you to a stile into Cherry Wood.

For the next half-mile you will follow a winding, but well defined track which takes you to the far end of the wood. Here you pass between two stone pillars of an old gateway to reach a grassy byway. Follow this to the right and then to the left and soon arrive at Raby. Keep forward, to pass the old Wheatsheaf Inn and reach Raby Mere Road. Your way is now left for a few yards and then right into Raby Road. A short walk along this lane brings you bak to the start.





Christmas Treats & Cakes make these holiday treats!

FUDGE - THE GOOD KIND!

In a heavy 2-quart sauce pan, mix together the following:

2-1/4 cups granulated sugar

3/4 cup evaporated milk

16 large marshmallows or 1 cup marshmallow cream

1/4 cup margarine

1/4 teaspoon salt

Cook, stirring constantly (as it may scorch) over medium heat and bring to a boil (mixture will be bubbling all over the top). Boil for 5 minutes longer, stirring constantly and then remove from heat.

Stir into this until completely melted - 1 cup semi-sweet chocolate bits, 1 cup of chopped pecan or walnut nut meats, and 1 teaspoon of vanilla. Spread into a buttered 8 x 8 inch square pan, cool, and cut into squares.

Like a sophisticated version of a chocolate log, this cake is flavoured with brandy and filled with a mixture of fresh cream and chestnut puree.

Chocolate Chetnut Yule log Preparation Time: 20 minutes 09 minutes



Chocolate Chestnut Yule Log Ingredients

100 grams Golden Icing Sugar (Billington's) 4 Free Range Eggs (Happy Eggs)

75 grams Plain White Flour (Allinson Nature Friendly)

25 grams Cocoa Powder

Additional Ingredients

2 tbsp Brandy, for the Filling 150 ml Double Cream Filling

100 grams Chestnut Puree, for the filling

75 grams Golden Caster Sugar 4 tbsp Water Buttercream 2 Free Range Eggs 100 grams Butter Buttercream

50 grams chocolate melted, for the Buttercream



Preheat the oven to 210°C/fan 190°C/Gas Mark 7. Brush a 22.5 x 32.5cm/ 9 x 13 inch Swiss roll tin with a little oil and line with greaseproof paper. Cut a second piece of greaseproof paper a little larger than the tin and sprinkle with 2 tsp of the caster sugar. Set aside.

Place the sugar and eggs in a large bowl and whisk until very pale and light, using an electric hand beater if possible, until the beaters leave a trail on the surface.

Sift together the flour and cocoa powder and gently fold into the egg mixture using a metal spoon. Pour into the prepared tin, tilting it so that it covers the whole surface. Bake for 7-9 minutes until firm yet springy to the touch. Turn out the cooked sponge on to the sugar paper. Peel away the lining paper and trim the edges. Cover with a damp tea towel and cool completely

When cooled, sprinkle the sponge with the brandy. Whip the cream until thick and stir in the chestnut puree. Spread over the sponge and roll up from one long edge

For the chocolate butter cream, place the sugar and water into a small pan and heat gently until the sugar dissolves. Boil rapidly until syrupy. Whisk the egg yolks together in bowl and continue whisking whilst adding the sugar syrup in a steady stream. Whisky until the mixture becomes thick, pale and cool, leaving a trail on the surface. Beat the butter in a separate bowl and gradually beat in the egg mixture until thick and fluffy. Stir in the melted chocolate, method tip Slice a 7.5cm/3 inch piece from the Swiss roll. Use a little butter cream to attach this piece to the side of the log, to represent a branch. Cover the log with the rest of the butter cream and use a skewer for fork to make a bark pattern.

Decorate with holly or a few small decorations

Tins:

Make the log 2-3 days before Christmas and keep refrigerated.





Cholesterol is a type of fat that is produced by the body, essential for good health. However high levels of cholesterol can increase the risk of heart disease and strokes. Abnormal levels are generally brought about by an unhealthy diet and inactive lifestyle, but can run in the family. A change of diet and exercise can lower cholesterol levels but if this is ineffective then medication may be prescribed as a last resort.

LDL cholesterol (low-density-lipoprotein) collects in the walls of blood vessels. causing blockages in the arteries by hardening and narrowing them. This can be tested for so actions can be taken to reduce the risks.

An LDL of less than 3.0 millimoles per litre (mmol/I) of blood is optimal for those not at high risk of heart disease.





For people at high risk of heart disease,

or with known heart disease, LDL less than 2.0 mmol/l is advised.

An LDL cholesterol-lowering diet is low in saturated fat. Avoiding processed foods and eating plenty of fruit and vegetables may further lower LDL levels.

Regular aerobic exercise lowers LDL cholesterol even further, and increases HDL ("good cholesterol") too.

HDL cholesterol (high-density-lipoproteins) are essential in keeping the blood vessels clean. They collect bad cholesterol and make them less harmful by transporting them to the liver and reprocessing them.

HDL cholesterol 1.2 mmol/L or more are desired

In general people with high HDL are at lower risk of heart disease. People with low HDL are at higher risk.

If your HDL is low, you can take several tacks to boost your HDL level and reduce your heart disease risk:

- Aerobic exercise for 30 to 60 minutes on most days of the week can help pump up HDL.
- Walking alone is not enough.
- Tobacco smoke lowers HDL, and stopping can increase HDL levels.
- Reduce alcohol consumption levels if this is an issue.
- Besides improving HDL levels, avoiding obesity reduces risk of heart disease and many other health conditions.

Welcome to the Lawnscience Late Autumn Newsletter.

Clocks have gone back, nights are drawing in, some might think there's not much work to be done on lawns. but that simply is not true. The lawn you have next Spring will be determined by how you look after it over Winter, so in this newsletter I will be providing tips on:

- Seasonal pests and diseases
- Winter work
- Preparation for next Spring

Pests and diseases

Every year thousands of lawns in the ÚK are needlessly destroyed by your lawns worst enemy, the Leatherjacket, These ferocious little "eating machines" literally devour your lawn's root system, causing your lawn to die within a few days.

The larvae of the crane fly leatheriackets. or daddy longlegs, are injected into lawns by their mothers during late Autumn, As

they start to grow they need a food source and your lawn's root system provides the perfect meal.




From December to late March we regularly receive calls from homeowners who have become prey to these "lawn eaters". By the time the problem has been discovered it's too late and the only solution is to either re-turf the lawn or provide extensive repairs which can run into hundreds of pounds.

However, there is a simple and cost effective solution, Lawnscience can apply an insecticide to your lawn which will kill off any leatherjackets which are living in your lawn. Late Autumn/Winter is generally the time of year when your lawn changes the least. However, you still need to be vigilant and monitor the health of your lawn carefully. One of the most common problems that can occur in your lawn over the Winter months, when day light hours are reduced, is the fungal disease Fusarium patch (Microdochium (Fusarium) Nivale). The disease (Fusarium) Nivale).

normally appears as patches of yellowbrownish grass or a white or pinkish mould, similar to cobwebs or cotton wool. Fusarium can develop overnight in a lawn if the conditions are right, it is particularly prevalent through late Autumn and Winter. Fusarium thrives in

conditions where there is a morning mist or dew and daylight hours are reduced. It is more likely to occur when the weather is milder and night time temperatures



are higher than average for Autumn or

If you are concerned that your lawn has a Fusarium infection I'd be happy to check it out for you, please send me an email or give me a call, contact details at the end of newsletter.

Worms are great for soil, they improve its condition, help recycle nutrients by eating dead plant material and they also improve soil structure, drainage and aeration as they endlessly tunnel within the soil. But they don't half make a mess of your lawn when they surface and leave casts on the lawn which then smear and cause the grass undemeath to die, creating perfect sites for weed germination in Spring, You can minimise casting by a treatment which reduces the number of worms coming to the lawns surface. Winter work



It's also not too late to have your lawn aerated. Aeration is probably the most effective single treatment you can apply to a lawn to perk it up and help it recover from periods of stress. The aeration process consists of driving thousands of holes into the lawns' surface. These holes help air, water and nutrients penetrate into the root zone which in turn builds up the root structure over the winter period, a time when a lot of repair work happens to the plants root structure. This period of recuperation helps create a revitalised lawn for the coming Spring.

There are two types of aeration, solid

core and hollow core. Solid core aeration just creates holes in the lawn, whilst hollow core creates holes by removing "plugs" of soil. Generally solid core is fine for most lawns, but if the lawn is "compacted" hollow core is more suitable. If you're not sure if your lawn is compacted, don't worry I have the tools to test your lawn. If you want a quote for aeration please send me an email or give me a call, contact details at the end of the newsletter.

Now is the time to start planning your lawn mower maintenance before you put it away in the shed and forget about it until Spring. When you have it serviced insist that the blades are sharpened and rebalanced...and check that the blades have been sharpened when you get it back as quite often this is forgotten! If you decide to service it yourself make sure you change the spark plug and sharpen and rebalance the blade or replaced it completely.

Preparation for next spring

If you want to make sure your lawn starts next spring looking nice and tidy now is a good time to trim those edges to give it the professional look. At the same time why not add mulch to your borders which, as well as improving its appearance, will also

prevent sudden changes in soil temperature helping prevent tender premature plant growth during winter warm spells. Such growth is killed easily in early spring by the return of cold winter temperatures.

Leaf removal is also a priority at this time. Leaving leaves on a lawns surface causes damage due to the grass being deprived of much needed light so the quicker you can remove them the better.


