

So you want to extend your home...

This may not be as difficult as you imagine, every year tens of thousands of people create additional living space without the need to move home.

This may take the form of a modest kitchen extension or a loft conversion, which, can provide a large bedroom and en-suite.

There are lots of legislation which require application to the local authority. Virtually everything you build (with the exception of some garages and porches) will require a Building Control Application, approval of the drawings, specification and possibly structural calculations.

Additionally the Building Control Officer will inspect the work as it proceeds and issues a completion certificate.

On the other hand by keeping within your "Permitted Development" rights you can build some single storey extensions and even loft conversions, without the need for planning approval... as with most things it's just a case of knowing the system.

This is were you will need an architect, building surveyor or designer who can produce the detailed drawings and specifications for submission to the local authority and also for builders to use in order to supply estimates.

It is always best to ask around for recommendations and obtain three estimates. Don't always choose the lowest estimate, you need to speak to the builder and ask about his previous work.

It might sound onerous, but it really isn't, with experienced professionals to guide you.







Caldy - The Wirral Way - West Kirby - Hoylake - Larton - Frankby -Stapledon Wood - Caldy (8 miles)

This walk takes in an old railway line, sand dunes, field paths and a quiet wood.

Caldy, a pretty village with its black and white timbered houses was at the beginning of the century, just a collection of huts and hovels. Then in 1832, R. W. Barton, a Manchester businessman bought the village and either rebuilt or renovated the whole village. The Barton family spent a great dela of money in Caldy; they built the church and their own home Caldy Manor.

From the car park of Wirral Country Park, set off along the Wiral Way with the Dee on your left. When you reach Cubbin's Green take in the magnificent views across the estuary, viewing the Welsh hills and beyond. Carry on the Wirral Way for about half a mile, looking ahead for a bridge crossing over the Way. Once reaching the bridge, climb the steps leading into Sandy Lane, where you turn left and follow the lane down to the Marine Lake. Turn right, and walk the length of the lake, either along the sea wall or along the promenade.

At the end of the Marine Lake after passing Dee Lane, drop down onto the beach, and continue ahead for a few minutes to reach the steps of a boardwalk. Walk through the dunes, between the sea and the golf links, for nearly half a mile.

It ends in Hoylake, at Stanley Road. Your way is now to the right and, at the end of this pleasant long road, at the junction of Stanley Road and The King's Gap you'll find The Green Lodge Hotel. Back in 1689, King William III took nearly 10,000 men to Ireland to embark in the Battle of the Boyne, William's victory over James II ended any possibility of a Stuart regaining the throne of England. The Green Lodge is a popular pub/hotel built over 220 years ago as a shooting lodge for Sir John Stanley, the Lord of the Manor. The hotel has some original walls and still regains the appearance of a stately house. There is an outstanding range of bar lunches including hot dishes and desserts. A well deserved resting point from the walk.

Continue the walk by crossing the top of Stanley Road into the King's Gap. When you reach the roundabout, go straight ahead to reach Station Road and into Carr Lane. Follow the lane as it turns left to pass a golf course and into Newhall Lane.

Soon, Carr Lane goes through an industrial estate and then turns right. The lane ends at a built up area and here you carry forward, into a tree-lined farm track. After crossing a one-step stile at the Map and pictures produced by kind permission of Derek Young. "Pictures from the Past".

side of a gate, keep forward until you come across a crossing path; now turn left. Walk about 200 yards and turn right over a stile, the path now runs straight ahead over the fields and, after crossing a wooden foot-bridge over the Birket, eventually broadens into a byway which ends at Long Rake Farm. From the farm cross the road and carry straight on along the lane signposted "Frankby". Soon on the left you will reach China Farm, just beyond which you turn left and enter a field. Don't take the farm track which follows the left hedge but cross the field diagonally right, towards a small plantation. Cross a stile, the go straight on over a step-stile and a small stone foot bridge. After leaving the trees, the path passes Larton Stables and becomes a wide track following the straight line to reach Frankby Road. Cross the road and pass through a bachelor gate, to follow a well troden path past Frankby Hall and leads you to another bachelor gate. Pass through the gate but do not go to the road. Instead, turn sharply to the right into a lane. This byway soon bears left, to pass Birch Hey Farm and then turns right, to arrive at a field gate. Turn left into a cart-track running between walls, and then keepstraight ahead. Views are stuning from here. In the first field, follow the right hedge as it drops down to a stone bridge leading into the next field. Here keep to the headge on your right, and go over a stile and into a pathway between houses. The path brings you to a step-stile where you reach Grange Cross Lane.

Your way is now left for 300 yards, look for a flight of steps in the wall. This is the entrance to Stapledon Wood. On entering the wood, take the left fork of the footpath and keeping the wall on your left follow the path through the trees until you reach a gap in the wall. The steps drop down to a path behind houses and very soon you pass through a wooden bachelor gate into Caldy Road. Turn right and travel down the road through the village, when you reach the centre of Caldy, turn right into Caldy Road and look for a stone memorial in front of the church. Cross the road here and enter the sandy byway. The path drops down into Croft Drive, and here turn right to pass Croft Drive West and continue in a straight line to reach the parking area of

Wirral Country Park.



THE WIGGINS EFFECT

This year has been a remarkable year for cyclists. The success of the British cycling team coupled with the outstanding individual achievements of Bradley Wiggins both at the Tour de France and the Olympic games has certainly entertained both cyclists new and old making cycling part of the fabric of everyday life for many.

Sadly, however every year in this country around 19,000 cyclists are killed or injured in reported road accidents. Of this number, around 3,000 cyclists are killed or seriously injured, with approximately one fifth of the cyclists killed and injured being children. 80% of accidents occur in daylight which emphasises the need for cyclists to wear bright clothing so as to make them more visible to motorists. The Highway Code states that cyclists should wear a cycle helmet and appropriate cycle clothing depending upon whether it is daytime or night.

Around three quarters of cyclists killed have major head injuries emphasising the importance of wearing a helmet. Bradley Wiggins has been campaigning to make the use of helmets compulsory for cyclists. Whilst it is currently not an offence to ride a bicycle without a helmet, it goes without saying that the use of helmets have saved numerous lives. A failure to wear a cycle helmet can also affect the level of damages you will receive if claiming damages for injuries sustained.

DID YOU KNOW?

- 1. Central Park, New York, Central Park architect, Frederick Law Olmsted, visited Birkenhead Park in 1850. Impressed by the landscaping in the Joseph Paxton designed public space, he used these principles in setting out Central Park. .
- 2. River Dee. The Dee Estuary is a Special Protection Area and supports many species of nationally and internationally important wildlife. There is also a River Dee in Scotland.
- 3. Wirheal, Wirheal was the Anglo-Saxon name for Wirral and means Myrtle tree (Wir) Corner (heal).
- 4. Historians have classified the Wirral Peninsula as the birthplace of England, after the Battle of Brunanburh 10. The area's oldest farmhouse is Old Hall Farm situated - present day Bromborough - in 937 brought together the might of England's combined armed forces for the very first time in order to fight the armies of both Norway and Scotland.
- 5. The peninsula's Leasowe Lighthouse, built in 1763. is the oldest brick built lighthouse in the U.K. The lighhouse was also the first in the country to have a female lighhouse keeper, when Mrs Mary Elisabeth Williams began her service as keeper in 1908.

- New Brighton, is home to the United Kingdom's longest promenade at 3.5 kilometres.
- 7. The peninsula's oldest pub is reputedly that of the Wheatsheaf Pub in Raby, which dates back to 1611.
- 8. The United Kingdom's oldest brick built lighthouse is situated on the Wirral Peninsula, at Leasowe shore. It was built in 1763 by the Liverpool Corporation Docks.
- 9. The area's oldest railway line was a branch line of the Birkenhead to Chester line, from West Kirby to Hooton, opened in September 1838. Although the line is now defunct, the line lives on in the form of the twelve mile long Wirral Way nature trail.
- in Chapel Lane, Moreton believed to have been built in 1719 for a Daniel and Mary Wilson.
- 11. Brimstage Hall situated in the picturesque village of the same name was apparantly built between the 12th and 14 th century, making it one of the peninsula's oldest buildings and certainly the oldest manorial residence in the area.
- 12. The Ministry of Defence's tidal activity research for the infamous D - Day landings of June 1944 were all taken at Bidston Observatory.

TREES IN THE LANDSCAPE


Q: A reader asks: How do you paint a tree grouping that looks other than just a blob of colour?

A: Painting tree groupings has always been a problem for the less experienced artist. There are many techniques used to paint individual trees. My Book 'Keith's Top Tips' - 170 tips shows various techniques for painting trees.

In any grouping there are likely to be a collection of different types of tree, displaying different shapes and heights. It is not necessary to know every type of tree, just how to paint them.

The painting illustrated displays such a range of shapes in various colours. I have painted each tree individually but as part of the whole. Note the wide range of greens represented, the colours being mixed using varying amounts of cadmium yellow, sap green, cobalt blue, raw sienna, cadmium orange and Payne's grey. A small amount of titanium white was used to lighten the colour combinations. Depth in the trees was a mix of Paynes grey/cobalt blue.



New Year - Fight the flab!



Ok it's that time of year again...

We have all over indulged at Christmas and New Year and want to shed a few or even a few hundred unwanted pounds !!!

Well, don't despair you don't have to sew your mouth shut or put a padlock on the fridge just yet. I'm going to list a few of what I think are the best tips to help you get rid of some of some unwanted fat and keep

- Get rid of all the "junk food" in your kitchen! I know I'm starting with a strong one here, but seriously this will help, if it's out of sight it's out of mind!
- Pack your fridge full of fresh fruit an veg. Get some chicken and lean cuts of meat and start googling healthy meal recipes. I do this myself and have found some great ones, chicken chilli stir fry being my favourite (using olive oil and fresh chillies).
