PAINTING AN ATMOSPHERIC SKY

Q: A reader asks: Have you got any advice to help me when painting my skies?

A: There is a golden rule when painting skies:

'A simple foreground requires an atmospheric sky' but a 'detailed foreground requires a simple sky'.

It is not as a rule a good practice to have a fussy sky and fussy foreground together.

In the painting illustrated - a Scottish seascape with lots of rocks and waves lashing against them, I felt a simple sky was not appropriate here.

I was unsure how detailed the sky should be until I had painted the rocks and sea so I decided to paint the sky in last to suit the foreground.

I painted a cobalt blue/alizarin crimson background leaving a white area with a subtle hint of raw sienna added in places to represent the cloud formations. All of my 11 books include many examples on how to paint skies.

20 PUB WALKS WALKS WIR ALL





Bromborough Cross - Bromborough Golf Course - Raby -Thornton Hough - Clatterbridge - Dibbinsdale -Bromborough Cross (Walking distance 9 miles)

This walk is through an unspoilt part of Wirral and, although you are never very far from residential areas, no sign of this is evident along the quiet paths and byways.

Bromborough is very old, at least 1,000 years, although little now remains of its antiquity. The ancient, respectable village, chiefly built of red sandstone, has largely been swept away, although a few old buildings remain. Even the market cross is modern, the steps are genuine 13th century, but the cross is far younger - a gift from the Bromborough Society.

To start the walk, go down Allport Lane, when you reach the crossroads turn right into Allport Road. Follow this pleasant tree lined road for half a mile, passing Bromborough station and continuing to into Raby Hall Road. Continue straight ahead along this road for abut 10 minutes and shortly after passing Blakeley Road look left for a signpost. This directs you over a stile into Bromborough Golf course, and you walk straight across to the motorway. Now your way is to the left over a step-stile, to follow a path along the edge of a large field (running parallel to the M53). The path ends at a further step-stile, which you cross and then turn right, into a short lane which crosses the motorway and brings you into Benty Heath Lane.

Now the way is to the left and at the next bend in the road look right for a signposted bridle-path. Follow this broad track (which can be very muddy in wet weather) for about 200 yards and then turn right, over a step-stile, to reach a fieldpath. This path follows the right hedge in a straight line over three fields, each of which is reached by crossing a plank-foot bridge and a stile, there is a particularly good view of Willaston Mill. This was Wirral's largest flour mill. It was built in 1800 and was in use until 1930, in that year a storm destroyed the sails and put it out of action for all time.

Leave the fields by way of a two-bar stile and stone steps and turn right, into a well trodden bridle path. Very soon the path divides, and here you take the left fork. The track now winds its way through the trees, crossing a small stream and passing a pond, to bring you to the Clatterbridge road. Your direction is now to the right and, after you have passed Benty Heath Lane, cross the road and turn left into Willow Lane. This byway brings you to Willowbrow Farm. Here you turn right, and a few minutes walk brings you to Raby. Beyond the old, thatched

Wheatsheaf Inn, you reach Raby Mere Road. Your way is now to the left for a few yards, and then right, into Raby Road. The steeple of Thornton Hough's parish church is now in sight and, a short walk along a pleasant lane, brings you to the Seven Stars Inn. This cheerful rural pub offers a wide range of pub food. In warm weather there is a very nice beer garden to relax in.

Leave Thornton Hough by way of Thornton Common Road and, after walking for 3 minutes, look left for Crofts Bank Cottages. Enter the lane by the side of the cottages and then turn right, to cross a stile and enter the fields. Go straight across the first field and keep the hedge on your right as you continue over the next 2 fields. Leave the 3rd field by crossing a 3-bar stile to meet a cart track. Cross this diagonally left, to reach another 3-bar stile. With the hedge on your right, cross the next field to reach another step-stile. The way now runs alongside the hospital for some distance between fence and hedgerow, to bring you to Clatterbridge Road, near the old Clatter Bridge.

Here you turn right and, when you arrive at the crossroads, the way is left, into Thornton Common Road. This pleasant rural lane follows a straight course for half a mile and then crosses the motorway. Soon the lane drops down to a narrow bridge and a crossing lane. Here you turn left - the road to the right takes you to Raby Mere. Follow the narrow byway as it winds uphill through the trees and eventually brings you to the junction with Poulton Road.

Go straight across Poulton Road to reach a 2-bar metal stile. In the cultivated field which follows, a raised footpath runs straight across to a further metal stile. Cross this stile to reach a well trodden track which bears right as it descends into Dibbinsdale. Cross the footbridge over Dibbinsdale Brook and then climb the steps to reach a steep track running through the trees. Soon you go over the railway into a housing estate. Keep forward into The Rake and, very soon, you are back at your starting point.

When a dog is presented to us in a severely matted condition, it is our policy to shave the whole coat using electric clippers with a close blade. We groom HUMANELY, to de-Matt would cause the dog tremendous stress and discomfort, often leaving a very thinned and damaged coat. Shaving the coat is quicker and more gentle on the dog. Many dogs are traumatised by unnecessary hours of de-matting, putting them off grooming for life. We consider shaving an act of kindness.

Once the coat is removed, the skin can be red due to the lack of air circulation and dirt that has accumulated underneath. Occasionally there are sores, these may need veterinary treatment. Dogs tend to scratch and rub their skin after the shaving, this is normal, however some dogs can over scratch and this may lead to broken skin. If in doubt speak to your vet.

Dogs feel different after shaving, lighter, off balance and cooler, most are glad to have freedom of movement again, and are full of life. Others seem to take it quite personally that they are bald, they hide and sulk for days. The skin will feel like suede and, depending on the colour of the dog, can be quite pink. Regardless of how the dog will look, he will feel 100% better.

Book your next appointment NOW, advance bookings ensure you get appointments at regular intervals at times that suit you. Your dog will always look and feel good keeping the coat and skin in a healthy condition.

Do not wait until he is matted again!

Now is also the best time to start a home grooming routing, the coat is short and manageable, begin gently stroking over the dog, make the grooming session pleasurable for owner & dog. SIZE OF WEDDING AND BUDGET

Decide on the size of your wedding. Remember to talk this over with your fiancé. A dream wedding for one might not suit the other - compromise and expectations are very important at this stage, you will need to know how many people are going to attend for venues, catering and invitations. Also, choose the size of your bridal party i.e. how many bridesmaids.

Set a realistic budget. While this is a very special day in your life, it's not an excuse to be wildly extravagant with money you don't have. You don't want to start your married life with stress over debts! If parents or family members are contributing to help you, find out how much they are willing to help with at the beginning, don't assume!

PLANNING

Reception venues can get booked up quick! Take a bit of time to visit several venues, keeping ideas of prices per head, what can be provided (saving you money) and dates available. You will also need to work with the service venue for dates!

RECORD-KEEPING

Choose the method for your record-keeping. You'll need to keep tabs of everything you've already decided and what's planned ahead. Invoices, quotes, receipts, seating plans, photos of desired decorations/clothing, patterns, instructions, etc. will need to be kept in one place, so have at least one large plastic pocket to keep these in one place. If you're more organised, use a few pockets, a notebook or a digital form of recording can be ideal - a mixture of both can work well too.

CHOOSE THE VENUE

The sooner this is done, the better so that you know you have the place you really want. Check out the spaces offered, the catering deals, the marriage fees, the ability to decorate a church or wedding space, etc. Find out whether the prices quoted cover everything or whether you'll be expected to pay for extras. Be aware that even church venues may charge fees. If planning your wedding well in advance, a great idea is to send out a 'save the date' card to your guests! (I think this is an American idea and a real good one!)

CHOOSE A THEME

It doesn't have to be anything really specific, but you want there to be a consistent feeling throughout. The colour of the bridesmaids usually blends in with the bouquet and flowers, ties and cravats, the cake, invitations, and decorations. Make sure the theme is easy to plan and decorate. Everything should be consistent with the theme.

As part of the theme research the flowers you want at the wedding. Find out if they're available during the time of your wedding. Finalise flowers around four months ahead of the wedding date.

Have wedding programs. As with the invitations, you can you have your programs professionally printed or make your own.

THE DRESS

Research, design and order your wedding dress around the mark of nine months to go, start researching your wedding dress ideas. Are you having one custom made or purchasing off-the-rack? Either way, you'll possibly need several fittings and adjustments to perfect it. Alternatively, make your own or steer clear of traditional wedding dresses and buy a dress that you simply love and know you can wear again after the wedding. You don't have to stick with tradition or spend a fortune on something you'll never use again.

Select a wedding well if you're having one too. And don't forget the shoes – from flip flops to diamond encrusted satin slippers, what's your preference and do they need special effort or will you buy them ready-made?

BRIDESMAID DRESSES & PAGE BOYS SUITS

Decide on bridesmaid's dresses at the same time. It's a good idea to take the bridesmaids with you, if possible, you need to make sure the style suits them and they like them!

MORNING SUITS

Around four months prior to the wedding is a good time to decide on styles (that suit) you will know by now the colour of your bridesmaid dresses and flowers so you can co-ordinate ties/cravats and waistcoats. It's a good idea to get sizes checked 4 weeks before the big day as a good fit is essential!

THE RINGS

Select the wedding rings. This is a fun task to do together, and symbolises your devotion to each other. Most couples get matching rings to show that they complete one another's soul. If you're having rings specially made (commissioned), leave plenty of time to get the rings exactly how you want them, all the thought, love and special meanings built in forever.

PHOTOS, VIDEOS AND MUSIC

Find a photographer and/or a videographer. Consider using a professional for this special occasion, and make sure that this person is reliable so that you don't have to worry about him or her forgetting your wedding or stuffing it up. There are just too many stories of relying on friends or family to do this aspect and years of regret as to fuzzy, out-of-focus shots or no footage at all because the photographer got carried away doing something else...

Is entertainment packed in with your venue or do you need to hire your own? Decide on whether you're going to have a soloist, band, quartet or a DJ. It's not recommended to do this part yourself with an iPod; there is more to wedding entertainment than just music! Professional musicians will keep the flow of the event, make announcements, and plan all your special events with you.

This aspect should not be booked last, because all the good bands and wedding DJ's get booked first! The entertainment is crucial and is what makes a wedding one to remember! It's recommended that you sort out this aspect of your wedding at least 10 months before the day.

THE CAKE

Pick a cake. Before settling on a cake it's best to have a tasting first. Also look into a cake that will match your theme, and please both the bride and groom. Sample cakes around eight months before the wedding and select the design at this time. Check in on the baker again a few months prior to the wedding to be reassured that your order is still on the books and ready to go as planned. It's best to have the cake delivered directly to the reception venue.

FOOD AND GIFTS

Decide what type of food and refreshments you will offer at the reception dinner. Try to find a happy medium between what would please your guests and what you can afford. Your venue will have tasting sessions where you can try samples of their range and make your choices mmmmm! If you are hiring a hall or a marquee, it is a sensible idea to hire a professional caterer, it's one less thing you'll have to handle personally.

GIFTS

Register for gifts when there are about 9 months to go until your wedding. This gives guests plenty of time to check your list and get the gifts.

TRANSPORT

Choose suitable transportation. If you have multiple venues, plan how you will travel from the ceremony location to the reception location. Some couples may choose to hire a limousine or ride in a classic car. Others like horse-drawn carriages. If it's popular with other people, book early.

If there will be alcohol at the reception, do you have a safe way for you and your bridal party to get home? It is worth hiring a suitable sized coach from a reliable company! this way everyone can enjoy themselves - if your budget doesn't stretch to this, guests will be very happy to pay a few pounds each not to have to worry about how they are getting home and finding enough taxis late at night. Remember, you want everyone to enjoy your wedding as much as you!

In some families it is tradition to decorate the couple's vehicle, so if you have a nice car, you may want to keep it at home in the garage!

BRIDAL SUITE AND HONEYMOON

(Plus accommodation for overnight guests)

Research the honeymoon locations and the wedding night room. Many couples book a "Bridal" suite the night of their wedding. Also, you may need to reserve a block of rooms for guests that will be attending your wedding. Booking as a group will usually ensure they all get the best rate but this should be done well in advance of the wedding.

Start researching where to go on honeymoon when there are about 8 months to go, so as to take advantage of special deals and good prices. Talk to your travel agent, let them know what you expect out of your holiday, lying on the beach and sea sports or visiting different villages/towns, travelling etc. they are the experts and will work with your budget and give you the benefit of their years of experience.

The final three months Finalise the vows

Buy or make wedding accessories, such as the ring bearer pillow, toasting glasses, favours, guestbook, flower baskets, table decorations etc.

Book hair, nail and makeup appointments (incl. trials to get it right!).

Prepare the ceremony program.

Plan the seating arrangements for the reception; plan for last minute revisions.

2 months to go:

Mail the invitations.

Schedule a wedding dress fitting, it might be your first or one of several.

Buy personal gifts or make gifts for members of the bridal party.

1 month to go:

Finalise all plans for the wedding ceremony.

Check that all bookings for hotels, transportation, venues, guest arrangements, etc. are as they should be.

Pick up the wedding rings if you haven't already done so Continue with dress fittings (many brides lose or perhaps even gain weight from stress, so final fittings should be as close to the time as possible, to ensure perfect fit).

3 weeks to go:

Write up the place seating cards. Continue with any fittings.

Check that you have relevant gifts for people. Chase up anyone who has not yet sent an RSVP to your invitations.

2 weeks to go:

Get the honeymoon packing done so that it's not worrying you Have last alterations made to dress; it should be ready by now Check all bills and make sure that all of your suppliers have been properly paid.

Follow up any loose ends, especially anything that is worrying you.

Have a hair trim.

1 week to go:

Aim to stay as relaxed as possible; you should have done most of it by now!

Collect your wedding dress if not done already, as well as any last accessories and shoes.

Keep everything in one place, covered and away from pets, kids and nosy people

Being a complete optimist about our English weather I love my flip flops. I heavily dislike shoes and socks, they are restrictive. I've never got on with shoes, often resulting in blisters, pinched toes or ankle pain. I love a high heel or a wedge for going out but every day shoes just annoys me and kicking them off is my favourite part of the day. I have often said if the streets were cleaner I'd be found walking barefoot. However like many women, I suffer from the dreaded dry & hard skin that often comes with preferring bare feet or flip flops to a full shoe.

Over the years, I've tried creams, exfoliators, 'ped eggs', a large variety of foot files from soft to 'oh my god that's vicious' grades of sandpaper attached to them, gels, magic potions from salons or chiropodists promising soft & smooth skin and I have suffered at the hands of shocking chiropodists who slice away skin to the point of bleeding, over enthusiastic Beauticians that may be more suited to career in Joinery not beauty and of course some of my less proud moments of going at the hard/skin myself with a pair of nail scissors in hope that lopping off slices of the skin would somehow make it look better.

Now at the grand old age of 32, I have found a regime that works for me and hopefully will for you; so here goes.

Stage 1: Find a good Chiropodist who you feel comfortable with and can treat your hard/dry skin with the contempt it deserves. The downside to a Chiropodist is they don't sort out your cuticles into. Spring

or paint your toes or allow your feet to soak in a refreshing foot spa or massage your feet for you. I have three appointments a year.

Appointment 1: March time to prepare my feet for my first pedicure.

Appointments 2: August time to keep on top of what I call 'flip flop' build up

Appointment 3: October time ready to put my feet away for winter.

A Chiropodist can also help with corns, calluses and array of other foot related issued that Beauty Salons cannot usually deal with.

The cost: Chiropody costs vary usually £20-£25. Over 60s discounts usually offered and if you have BUPA or a health plan you may also be covered.

Stage 2: Find a good Salon to do the nice bits. Depending on what you are after most salons offer everything from a straight forward file & polish of your tootsies to a fully luxury pedicure. Personally I like a Luxury Pedicure, it complements the work the Chiropodist does, From the foot soak to the leg, ankle & foot massage to the cuticles being removed to polish being applied a Pedicure really is a treat for your feet and for your soul. I have two luxury pedicures a year (March & October) the rest of the time I opt for a file & polish

The cost: File & Polish from £6-£12, Pedicure costs usually from £15-£30 depending on level of Luxury. Over 60s discounts usually offered.

Stage 3: Keep on top of your feet at home or your feet may

not like you;

Who hasn't had aching sore feet after a long day at work, running after children or even a long days shopping. Remember to treat your feet to some home care. Invest in a good quality vitamin e rich cream and slather your feet in it then wear some socks to help soak the cream in. Buy yourself a good foot file and pumice stone then gentle rub the soles of your feet every couple of days in the bath or shower to help keep the dry/hard skin at bay.

The cost: Good Quality foot cream from £3-£20, Pumice Stone from £2-£12 and Foot File from £2-£20

Top Tips:

- Expensive products/services don't always mean the best results so don't feel you have to pay for the dearest to get the best.
- Don't go at your feet yourself to remove dry/hard skin cos you may cause infection &/ or seriously hurt yourself then you won't be in those sexy sandals just a NHS blue booty and there are no outfits that go with those!
- Use a reputable Chiropodist and Beauty Salon
