

20 PUB WALKS WALKS WALKS WALKS





Gayton - Manor Wood - Thornton Hough - Raby - The Runnell - Parkgate - Dee Shore - Gayton (Walking distance 9 miles)

A walk which includes a stretch of woodland, green lanes, fieldpaths and an old sea-wall.


From the Glegg Arms, go to the left along the Chester Road walking for about 15 minutes, shortly after the road has passed over the Birkenhead - Wrexham railway, you will see two signposts on the left, one heading towards Bebington and the other in the direction for Brimstage. Go over the nearby stile and turn left to follow a grassy path along the edge of a field with the railway on your left. Soon the path bears right, into the trees and, for the next 10 minutes, becomes a winding track leading you through a delightful stretch of woodland. A one-step stile brings you to a well-trodden path leading along the edge of Manor Wood. In time, the path broadens as it runs between high, wooden hoardings. Shortly after passing under two ornamental bridges, the path brings you to Manor Road. Now turn to the right.

The road leads you past the entrance to Thornton Manor. Keep forward through the village to enter Raby Road. Raby is an unusual village, it is without a church, school or even a shop, just farmhouses and cottages and, of course, it's famous inn.

The Wheatsheaf Inn or (as it is affectionately known by locals) 'The Thatch'. This is a half timbered, whitewashed, thatched building, one of Wirral's most attractive pubs, dating from 1611. The Cow Shed restaurant is attached where they serve beautiful meals.

When you leave the pub, turn right and walk the few yards to reach Raby Mere Road. Now turn left and walk to the gate at the side of the red telephone box at the top of Raby Road. A gap at the side of this gate admits you to a wide, grassy path which runs between hedges to bring you out into Neston Road, close to Yew Tree Farm. Go straight across the road to a sandstone wall, which you cross by means of steps, to reach a narrow path. This winds its way through overgrown briar and bramble for 1/4 mile before bringing you to the Chester High Road. Go across and then turn right. After walking for 5 minutes you will reach The Runnell. Turn left down this quiet yay which, in time, takes you over the Birkenhead - Wrexham railway and brings you to Leighton Hall Farm.

Pass the farm and turn left into a winding lane. Not far ahead, on the right of the lane, you reach a bachelor gate leading into a field. Go straight across the field to a further bachelor gate. This brings you into a narrow path which quickly becomes

a short lane, leading into Wood Lame. Here you need to turn left and 100 yards ahead turn right into a fieldpaths running alongside a bridle-path. Go forward, passing under a wooden footbridge, along Brookland Road, and so into The Square at Parkgate.

From The Square, turn right and make your way along the sea-front to the Boathouse Restaurant. DO NOT follow the road to the right, but keep past the restaurant to arrive at the Country Park picnic area - the site of the old open air swimming baths. Keep forward until you reach a sandstone wall, climb the steps leading to the top of the sea wall. Now continue ahead with the Dee shore on your left and the smooth greens of Heswall Golf Links on your right.

Five minutes' walk along the wall brings you to a footprint sign directing you to the right, across the golf links. On reaching a wooden bachelor gate, go through to cross the Wirral Way to another bachelor gate admitting you to the links again. Go straight across to reach stone steps leading into a well trodden path. Here you turn left and follow a narrow path which, in summer, becomes a leafy tunnel. Soon the track broadens to become a sunken lane which will take you past the golf course entrance. Go forward for a further 50 yards and then look right and, in a recess of the old stone wall, you will see the head of a well (known as the 'Pinwell') which was used for hundreds of years as a water supply.

Continue forward into the cobbled village of old Gayton. Gayton Hall on the right was, for centuries, the home of the Glegg family. in 1689 King William III spent the night here. He must have enjoyed himself as he bestowed a knighthood on his host!

Now turn right into Well Lane, a pleasant, tree-lined byway which leads you uphill to the crossroads at Gayton.












Stop your dream holiday becoming a nightmare!

Many of us spend two weeks abroad and the other 50 thinking about them but while theft may be the furthest thing from your mind when you head off on your longed-for break, sadly tourists are a target for holiday thieves of all descriptions from conmen to pickpockets.

Obviously you want to relax and enjoy your well-earned week or two in the sun but letting down your guard could be disastrous and turn your dream holiday into a nightmare. But there are a few simple steps you can take to ensure you don't become a victim and can still have fun in the sun. You can do a lot to protect yourself and your possessions even before you leave home. Nowadays identity theft is an increasing problem in resorts, so make sure you take a photocopy of your passport in case the worst should happen.

If you are using travellers cheques, keep a separate record of the serial numbers and the details of any credit or debit cards you'll be taking. Consider using a pre-paid currency card - you'll get a better exchange rate if you load your required currency on your card before you travel and as they're not linked to your bank account, thieves won't be able to access your personal information. Where possible, pay for your accommodation in advance. Not only will you get a better rate, you're also guaranteed somewhere to stay if your money is stolen.

Once you check in to your hotel room, make sure you never leave anything important in sight, and that you lock the door and windows every time you go out. And while it may sound silly, try not to dress or act like a tourist. Wear clothing that will blend in so as not to attract attention - and leave the bling for nights out.

Sunglasses are a great way of avoiding eye contact, particularly from "over-friendly" locals who want to practise their English on you on the way to their cousin's carpet factory. Don't carry more cash than you need and be discreet when handling money. Keep a close eye on how much you're giving and always check your change as unsuspecting, harassed tourists can easily become an extra source of income for unscrupulous shop clerks. Try to avoid using high denomination notes for small purchases. A wallet in the back pocket of your jeans is simply an invitation to pickpockets and women should wear handbags strapped across the body instead of on one shoulder to avoid snatching. Ideally, a money-belt under your clothing is the most secure way of keeping cash and cards safe, although a smaller purse or wallet in a secure pocket is advisable for everyday purchases if you want to avoid undressing in a shop to get at your money. If you don't have travellers cheques and you need to pay your bill at a restaurant, insist on giving the cashier the card personally and watch them as they put it through the machine as this will cut the chances of your details being stolen or your card being cloned.

Use your common sense when walking around - keep clear of dark, empty streets at night and stay near groups of people if possible. In the event that you follow all the advice and you're still unlucky enough to be mugged, don't resist. No amount of money is worth your life. Don't panic and inform the police before ringing your credit card and travellers cheque companies. In most cases your money and cards will be replaced within 24 hours, and you won't be liable for any charges.

PAINTING REFLECTIONS

Q: A reader asks: How do you paint realistic looking reflections in water?

A: In the painting shown, the reflections play an important part. What you are attempting to represent are the background colours from the land and trees reflecting in the water. In fast flowing water the reflections are seen simply as various tones with little detail but in a slow moving river, the reflections will be seen in more detail. In this scene where the water in the pond is virtually static, the reflections were painted by drawing a flat brush loaded with paint vertically downwards over the light toned underpainting that was not too wet. The brush was loaded with the different

colours represented in the background and holding it virtually flat to the surface drawn downwards. To soften the effect, the brush was drawn horizontally across the surface whilst the paint was still moist.

Note: that to achieve a sense of distance, the background was painted in little detail and colour.



Make the most of your fuel finances

Well over half the money spent on fuel bills goes towards providing heating and hot water in a typical UK household. So in these times of ever-increasing costs, having an efficient and cost-effective heating system is vital - and it's one of the main steps you can take to reduce your carbon dioxide emissions. Some householders may be put off by the initial costs but can be assured they will soon recoup the outlay which will continue to pay dividends in the future. The Energy Saving Trust says the first step to saving energy from heating is to understand your system. Nearly all homes have either a central heating system - a boiler and radiators - or electric storage heaters. Central heating is the most common where a boiler heats up water that is pumped through pipes to radiators throughout the house, as well as providing hot water to the kitchen and





bathroom taps. Most boilers run on mains gas but in areas where it's not available, the boiler can run on oil, tank gas, coal or wood. Mains gas is usually the cheapest and has the lowest carbon emissions, apart from wood. Some boilers also have an electric immersion heater as a back-up. Gas and oil boilers may be combination (combi) boilers, in which case they heat the hot water as it is needed and don't need to store it. Otherwise, the boiler heats up water and stores it in a cylinder that feeds the taps.

If you have this system, the Trust advises a number of energy-saving options:

 Replace your boiler with a newer, more efficient model
 Fit better controls for your space and water heating - and use them to make sure your boiler only provides heat when you want it • Switch to a cheaper or lower carbon fuel or technology • Make any insulation and draught-proofing improvements that you can • Use chemical inhibitors if you have an older system.

Nearly all gas boilers fitted in Britain since 2005 are condensing boilers which have are able to recover more heat from the burning gas, making them more efficient. You can tell which one you have by checking the flue - flues made of plastic are condensing while metal ones aren't. Condensing boilers also have a plastic pipe coming out of the bottom, through the wall and into a drain. Trust experts advise householders to consider replacing your boiler with a newer, more efficient model if they don't have a condensing boiler. Whether to opt for a combination or regular boiler really depends on your lifestyle and needs. A regular boiler is actually more efficient than a combi at producing hot water in the first place but some heat is inevitably lost while the water is stored in the cylinder, so a combi may be more efficient overall. Electric storage heaters which heat up overnight using cheaper offpeak electricity, giving out heat during the day are more common in flats, rented property and homes without mains gas. One of the most expensive heating options around, it also emits more carbon dioxide than most and is harder to control than radiators, especially with older systems. If you have storage heaters, you will probably have a hot water cylinder heated by one or two immersion heaters. In this case, the Trust advises replacing the entire lot with an efficient boiler system where possible; installing new, more controllable storage heaters, fitting thermostats and controls to make the system more efficient, and looking into insulation and draught-proofing improvements.

Caring For Our Canines' Teeth

Bad breath in dogs is the butt of many a joke but in reality it's no laughing matter. Dental disease affects up to 80% of pets over the age of three and - just like humans - there can be serious health consequences. The sooner you start looking after your dog's teeth the better. Dogs start life with 28 baby teeth which fall out by the age of six months and are replaced by 42 permanent ones. If these baby teeth don't fall out and the permanent teeth start to grow underneath them, this can lead to problems like increased tartar, bite difficulties and gum irritation. One of the first signs of dental disease is often bad breath. Dogs with dental problems can also be reluctant to eat or play with toys, be lethargic, and have bleeding gums and eroded teeth. But the problems aren't just confined to the mouth. The heart, kidneys, intestinal tract, and joints may also be infected as mouth infections produce bacteria which can attack other parts of the body. A vet with leading pet food manufacturer Butcher's describes proper dental care as the foundation of dog health and wellbeing. He advises owners to watch out for unpleasant mouth odour, varying appetite, bleeding gums, swelling under the eyes and general apathy as these are signs of a major oral inflammatory illness. He says: *During a visit to a veterinary surgery, the vet would also detect large quantities of teeth tartar, partial or whole tooth decay, inflamed gums, and in some instances just a gentle touch to the gum area could cause heavy bleeding between the teeth caused by food debris. In this condition teeth may well be removed. Dental treatment in dogs unfortunately requires a general anaesthetic and the procedure would include cleaning all the teeth, checking the condition of the teeth and, if necessary, removing a tooth. Neglected teeth and gums is a place for bacteria, which then attack other parts of the body including the gastrointestinal tract, weakening the immune system and potentially leading to inflammation of the

heart muscle or even an infection in the joints and bones". The best way to avoid such conditions is prevention. From the early months of life, a puppy should, initially in the form of fun, get used to having their teeth brushed. This can be done with a special dog toothbrush and dog toothpaste. For best results, as with humans, clean the teeth every day. Dog toothpaste is fluoride-free so there is no harm done if your pet eats or swallows the paste and as it is meat or fish flavoured, you can understand the temptation! Another method of prevention advised is to use special fluids that can be added to drinking water, which contain safe and appropriate disinfectants to help clean the teeth without the need for brushing. Similar formulations are also available in gel form which can be applied to the gums. Dog food can also play a big part in the prevention programme. A small amount of plaque, on the top of the crown particularly, can be mechanically removed by feeding dry food.

The vet adds: "Matching the size of the dog food with the appropriate kibble size will ensure that your dog bites the kibble, and will therefore have some effect". Administering chews or bones will also help to clean the teeth. Regular visits to your vet are also an important element of prevention to ensure your pet pooch has a happy and healthy life.

I really dislike those people who smoked for 20 years then stop, the ones that wave their hands around and cough in that over exaggerated way and pretend to gag whenever someone smokes next to them... I also really dislike the 'born again veggie' too who after 40 years of loving a bacon butty, a dirty kebab on a Friday night or a BBQ beef burger goes on to refer to meat as 'murder' and 'cruel'.

I'm not going to be one of those 'born again' people preaching to you about the risks you take in the sun, I want to share with you what the sun means to me and how I've learned from some pretty amazing mistakes.

Hello, my name is Becki Edwards and I am a sun worshiper. (Spoken like a true addict eh?)

I love nothing more than the feel of the sun on my body. I wear flip flops from March to October and vest tops all year round. If you see me in a t-shirt or long sleeved top then you know it is cold and if you see me in my old faithful blue timberland boots then its snowed pretty bad. I detest the winter.

I've always loved the sun, I remember summers spent in the back garden in our powder blue square framed paddling pool which our gorgeous German Shepherd, Gina also used to cool down in so was held together with so much duct tape where her claws had ripped the bottom it was a patch work quilt of rubber and tape. I remember spending time in Nan & Grandads garden dead heading flowers, digging out veg patches and looking after Grandads prize fruit, veg and flowers. I remember summers spent in the river at Bedgelert and the beaches at Treaddor Bay and Rosneignr watching the planes come into Valley. I remember spending summers at race tracks up and down the country watching bike and car racing with my Mum, brother and sister, the smell of two stroke fuel, burning rubber and sun tan lotion. I love these memories.

Until four years ago I've done things to get a tan that would amaze people but at the same time some of you may cringe and know you've done exactly the same as me all in the name of bronzed skin and a healthy glow. I've used baby oil, baby lotion, moisturiser, tanning oils, carrot oil, cooking oil, olive oil, white vinegar and absolutely nothing at all. I've used sunbeds since I was 16, sometimes for 15 minutes at a time and several times a week, I am dark haired (virtually black), with funny coloured eyes (they change from green to brown depending on my mood, level of tiredness or drunkenness) my skin is medium to dark. I usually tan by going lobster red then I wake the next morning I'm brown and ready to start again, once

I've done this a few times I tend to just go brown, brown, brown, dark brown and then mahogany.



So what changed? Well, without going all X Factor sob story on you.... Cancer happened, not to me but to my Uncle. Four years ago I lost my Uncle to the secondary cancers caused by a primary skin cancer, My Mum was devastated and made me promise never to go on a sunbed again, and I haven't. Since Rod (the Uncle) died I have been more conscious of my sun bathing habits and have changed them so I can still enjoy my sun, my sun helps me be a happier person, a sun tan helps me be more confident and the energy boost it gives me is like a drug I just can't give up so instead of giving it up I changed and I'm going to share my findings with you:

Exfoliating and Moisturising is secret number one: Ok so it's no big secret I just do it more often than most. I have found to keep a good tan I have to really keep on top of my exfoliating and moisturising. I do it daily using exfoliating gloves and weekly using a salt scrub. I don't go too aggressive just enough so my skin feels refreshed. I use a good quality body butter to make sure I don't dry out from the scrubs.

The cost: Exfoliating gloves £1-£5.
Good quality Scrub from £5 to £30
(personal favourites Soap & Glory Flake
Away or Sanctuary Salt Scrub), Good
quality moisturiser/body butters £5 to
£30 (personal favourites Soap & Glory
Righteous Buttler)

Good quality sun creams for face and body: I use a face cream with a good SPF in every day through winter, spring, summer and autumn. I also rub this around my neck, throat and ears. During the summer I wear a sun cream every day, a good quality with a factor of 15-25 depending on what I'm doing and when I say every day I mean every day. In the morning my sun cream is my moisturiser, as I said earlier I wear vest tops so my arms, chest and back are always exposed, how many of us have been out for lunch or a shopping trip and have felt the 'burn' afterwards? I know I have, many times.

The cost: Face Cream £10-£???, Sun Creams £10 - £???? (My personal favounte Ecran Lemon Oil products)

Exfoliating and Moisturising whilst I tan is how I keep my tan, my legs were always a nightmare to tan but this way they tan like the rest of my body, I do exfoliate and moisturise whilst I've been on holiday too as I've found it freshens the skin surface however this is only because I've not burned myself, if you are burnt then please DON'T go exfoliating as you will cause yourself more harm than good.

When I go on holiday I do try to stay out of the sun at its height (12pm - 3pm) but it's not always possible, so I make sure I wear a high factor, slather it on often, wear a hat or bandana and keep hydrated (and I don't mean gin & tonic)

I don't burn now, I used to though. Now I can sit in the sun and being sensible doesn't mean boring, being sensible means I no longer feel the burn in bed at night where my skin is tight or the shower stings my skin or I have to stay out of the sun because I'm burned to a crisp.

In August last year I had it hit home even harder when my best friend, my rock, my soul mate, my everything was diagnosed with melanoma (skin cancer) it's the most aggressive type and can spread, she was operated on, she has check-ups with Consultants and she has to do daily checks on herself. She's ok, she's alive but after years of doing exactly what I did she has learnt she can't do it anymore without consequences. We will sit in the sun this year together, we will enjoy our lunch and a few drinks but we will be doing whilst slathered in sun lotions and potions looking after not only our skin but our health and our future. I want to be sat having a drink and lunch in the sun with this person into our 80s so we've both learnt a hard lesson.

Who knows these changes I've made could be too little too late but I'm hoping I'm doing enough now to ensure I protect myself and my future.
