ranmere made a brilliant start to life in the non-league, with victories over Woking and Gateshead helping a freshly assembled squad hit the ground running. Many of the new recruits made strong first impressions, while manager Gary Brabin won his first two competitive matches, something no Tranmere manager had done since Brian Little in October 2003.

The first of those games was at home to Woking, a decent side that finished just outside the playoffs last year. This was Tranmere's first match outside the Football League since 1921, and a fantastic crowd of 5,583 assembled at Prenton Park, by far the largest anywhere in the National League that day, and more than five times what some rival clubs generated. Among the number were over 2,500 season ticket holders, a tribute to Rovers' magnificently loyal supporters, who've stuck with their team despite successive relegations.

There was a tremendous atmosphere inside the stadium throughout, with excellent weather contributing to a poignant scene, as Wirral once again united behind its premier sports team. The game was often attritional, as Rovers struggled with nerves and Woking appeared determined to make the most of their big day out. In fact, after a prolonged midfield battle, the visitors created the best chance of the first half, when John Goddard saw his shot cleared off the goal line by Tranmere defender Matt Hill.

However, during the half-time interval, Brabin seemingly cajoled an improvement from his players, who pressed higher up the field and gained greater control of possession in the second period. Meanwhile, the Woking players were deflated by a horrendous injury to star striker Scott Rendell, who sustained season-ending knee ligament damage in a first half collision.

On 58 minutes, Rovers won a free-kick twenty yards from goal. Up against part-timers, the hosts' extra professionalism told, as a rehearsed set play yielded the first goal. Liam Ridehalgh and James Norwood feigned to shoot directly, wrong-footing the Woking defensive wall, before captain Steve Jennings tapped the ball square to central midfield partner Jay Harris, whose phenomenal strike veered sweetly into the top corner, sending Prenton Park into absolute delirium.

In a display of refreshing steel, Rovers held on for an opening day victory. In recent seasons, the Superwhites have struggled with an unhealthy habit of throwing away leads and losing points from winning positions, so it was very pleasing to see Brabin's men close out an important victory. Indeed, it was just great to finally see Tranmere win again, something they hadn't managed at home in 168 excruciating days.

"I'm delighted," said Brabin on his first win as Rovers boss. "I thought it was important that we got off to a good start. This is where it starts now. We're going to get stronger, we're not the finished article by any means, but it's pleasing to start the season with a clean sheet and three points."

From there, Rovers had very little time to recuperate before venturing to Gateshead, which promised to be a stark introduction to life outside the Football League. However, where recent Tranmere teams would have struggled for confidence at such a venue, we saw the new regime's positive influence, as Brabin's side produced a performance of remarkable control and spirit.



After an initial period of adjustment, during which both teams got to grips with one another, Tranmere's superior quality shone through, with three goals in fourteen minutes killing the game off, to the delight of 453 fans who travelled from Merseyside. Rovers took the lead after half-an-hour, when a brilliant exchange between strike partners Andy Mangan and Cole Stockton unleashed the former behind Gateshead's defence. Mangan squared across the face of goal, where Ridehalgh, playing as a left winger, beat his marker to tap home.

Ten minutes later, Ridehalgh played a role as Rovers doubled their lead; his corner kick finding defender Ritchie Sutton, whose movement exploited a statuesque defence, and whose glancing header put Tranmere 2-0 up. It was noticeable that the entire Rovers team celebrated in unison, suggesting there is a tremendous camaraderie within the squad, something distinctly lacking at Prenton Park in recent years.

The player's mood was further enhanced when Rovers took a 3-0 lead on 44 minutes. Tranmere knocked the ball around in neat and nimble exchanges, before right-back Michael lhiekwe arrived at the back post to ram home a teasing cross from the mercurial Ridehalgh. Gateshead managed to pull a goal back before half-time through Jon Shaw, but, in the second period, Rovers were exemplary in taking the sting from any attacks and simply coasting to victory.

However, the Superwhites did manage to add a further goal to their tally before the final whistle, when left-back Matt Hill won possession in his own half, galloped some twenty yards over the halfway line, and, from an enormous distance, unfurled a darting shot that floated over the stranded goalkeeper and into the bottom corner for an early Goal of the Season contender. It was a magical moment for Hill, who struggled with serious injury last season but always remained positive, even amid an arduous relegation battle. He deserved his moment of joy, and Rovers deserved their emphatic 4-1 win.

A few days later, Tranmere were finally dealt something of a reality check away to Braintree Town, who set out specifically to stifle any fluidity from their illustrious opponents. Before a minuscule crowd of 838 in Essex, Rovers struggled for tempo and continuity, with the hosts quick into tackles and a messy midfield battle consuming much of the ninety minutes. Chances were few and far between, but Tranmere substitute Adam Mekki had perhaps the clearest opportunity deep in stoppage time, but his effort was ultimately tame as the final whistle blew on a fairly mundane result.

Nonetheless, Gary Brabin will be pleased with his start as Rovers manager. The opening fortnight was always destined to be tough for Tranmere, who, following relegation to the fifth tier, were in for a rude awakening against Woking, before trips to either end of the country against hardened opposition in Gateshead and Braintree. Thus, to have travelled 850 miles in the space of five days and still managed to keep two clean sheets and accumulate 7 of a possible 9 points, is an achievement to be content with. It provides Rovers with a firm footing from which to build their promotion challenge.



# What makes the perfect

When considering the perfect garden most of us want perfect manicured lawns, pretty, neat flower beds and perhaps a charming water feature. But how useable is a garden where everything has its place? And how much can kids enjoy it?

The typical British garden is all about a nice patch of lawn and a


good stock of summer flowers, perhaps a patio for BBQs and maybe even a swing. But thinking about how your garden will really work for you can turn the typical


backyard in to a family paradise, whether large or small. Observe how children use a garden - they touch, smell, taste, they run around and they pull up flowers. Little girls love daisies as much as they love roses, little boys like getting down in the grass as much as playing on a swing. Banish ideas about neat, straight lines, weekly mowing and coordinated colours. If you have a lawn why not leave a section wild and unmown? Here bugs will breed, frogs might hide and wild flowers and grasses will sow, children and adults alike will love laying in the tall grass, family pets will hide in it and bound through it.

When it comes to planting beds, pick plants for their colour and the way they feel, things that smell unusual or beautiful or are edible. Use tall, round alliums, spiky grasses, aromatic herbs, smooth, furry lambs ear, plumes of astilbe and cut and come again lettuces, don't be afraid to mix vegetables in

to flower beds, plant edible flowers such as nasturtiums, sweet peas or asters in bright, garish colours which can be picked without issue. Avoid those plants that are irritating or poisonous and learn the names of everything you plant to teach to small children learning new words - plant names are exciting and unusual to curious little people.







In the same way, fill your garden with piles of logs, upturned pots and large rocks under which spiders, caterpillars, ants and beetles can be found or even in which hedgehogs can hide. This will encourage young children not to be afraid of bugs and creepy crawlies and help to teach them about basic biology. Not to

mention hours of fun catching butterflies or counting spots on ladybirds.

Beauty in a garden doesn't have to mean pink climbing roses, neat rows of cabbage or modernist sculpture, in a family garden it's beauty should be in discovery, excitement and usability and there's nothing neat and tidy about that.

ad behavior by your four-legged family members can create disruptions that range from a minor nuisance to full-out frustration.

In fact, leading veterinary organizations report that behaviour problems are the leading cause of pet euthanasia and account for as much as 80 percent of pet abandonment.

Warmer weather fosters many of the activities and situations that can bring out the worst in pets such as family travel, loud noises from increased activity in the neighbourhood or fireworks, and ceaseless barking in the yard or on a walk.

Fear and stress are common triggers for behaviour problems in pets, so taking steps to reduce the impact of scary and stressful situations can make a big difference.

#### **Travel**

While some pets can't wait to hop in the car and take off, others experience stress and fear from travel. For some, it is the motion of the vehicle, and for others it may be the fear of unfamiliar environments. With a grasp of basic commands, as well as a little planning on the part of the owner, your pet can enjoy a more comfortable travel environment.

- Keep your pet in a carrier during the journey. Include a favorite blanket or toy in the carrier to increase comfort and provide reassurance.
- Set the carrier out several days in advance, leaving the door open to allow your pet to explore it without fear of immediate departure.
- During the journey, allow your dog to exercise and relieve themselves every two hours. For cats, put a litter tray in the car, along with some water, and allow them to roam free in the car every few hours.
- The calming effects of pheromones are a proven way to help reduce the fear that traveling can cause in dogs and cats. #### Loud noise

# Signs of Stress in Dogs and Cats

Like people, pets respond differently to stressful situations, and circumstances that one pet copes with easily can create extreme duress for another.

- Destructive behavior such as chewing furniture and other items in the home
- Excessive barking, both inside and outside the home
- Urinating and defecating around the house
- Sudden displays of growling, snarling and even biting family members that your dog is normally affectionate toward
- Physical signs of illness such as vomiting, diarrhea, loss of appetite, skin allergies, excessive licking and pulling out dumps of fur

When it comes to cats it can be more difficult to pick up signs of stress because signals such as hiding or sleeping out of sight are normal behaviors. Sometimes the escalating level of feline stress is gradual. Be aware that these situations can cause cats to feel stressed:

- Loud music
- · Strangers in the home, such as repairmen
- A barking dog or new pets
- New family members, such as a baby and visitors
   New furniture





IN THE GARDEN

If you've got a garden, hedgehogs are useful visitors. They will eat slugs, beetles, caterpillars and a variety of other insects.

To attract hedgehogs to your garden you can try providing a natural shelter using log, leaf and compost piles (always check before moving the pile or having a bonfire) or allow patches of bramble to grow up, creating 'wild' areas. You could also place a piece of board against a pile of bricks to form a type of bivouac or buy a purpose built hedgehog house.

Hedgehogs can travel around a mile every night so, to provide access to enclosed gardens, try cutting holes in fences, removing bricks from walls, or digging tunnels under the garden boundary.

This will allow local hogs to move freely in and out of your garden. Food and fresh water laid out between February and October will encourage visiting hedgehogs to return regularly. You could try leaving out food such as minced meat, fresh liver, tinned dog food (not fish-based), or even scrambled eggs. Remember to check and replace the food and water daily and dispose of food if not eaten.

Hedgehogs like milk but it may give them diarrhoea. So it's best to give hedgehogs plain, fresh water each night in a shallow bowl. They should never be given cows' milk.





#### Hedgehog friendly gardening...

**GARDEN PONDS** can be death traps to small animals - make sure there is always an easy route for hedgehogs to climb out of the water. Steps built out of house brick or wire mesh are often used in ponds. Alternatively, make sure the pond has a gentle slope on at least one side. Ideally, swimming pools should have shallow steps and a tight-fitting insulating cover should be used overnight. Remember to check your pond or pool every day!

**STRIMMERS** should be used sparingly under hedges and in other areas of undergrowth and always make sure you check any areas you want to cut or strim before starting - hedgehogs and other animals are likely to be resting there during the day.

**DRAINS** and similar open holes frequently trap unwary hedgehogs and they can starve if they are not rescued. Keep all drain covers in good condition and cover any open holes.

LITTER is a real hazard - hedgehogs frequently get their heads stuck in tins, plastic bags, binders from drinks cans or discarded yoghurt pots - make sure you dispose of your rubbish safely. Bin bags left on the ground will also attract hedgehogs, they might try to nest in them and get put out with the rubbish!

**NETS** particularly those used for tennis, football or cricket, must be furled well above the ground when not in use - hedgehogs often get entangled and die of starvation. Fruit nets are a similar source of danger but can be kept taut to stop animals getting entangled. Make sure all barbed wire is also kept off the ground.







Drop by rounded teaspoons about 2 inches apart onto prepared sheet. Bake 8-10 minutes or until edges are lightly browned. Cool 1 minute; remove to wire rack.







Being brought up with strict Victorian values Ursula went on to sing in the club scene in Liverpool at the start of the Merseybeat.


