





Above: 1912. The sign for the Argyle Theatre can be seen in the centre of this photograph looking down Argyle Street Birkenhead with Grange Road off to the left. The theatre was opened 21 December 1868 by Dennis Grannell. His nephew, Dennis Clarke, became sole manager in 1891 and it was he who was responsible for making this one of the best known theatre's outside of London. It received a direct hit during bombing raid 26 September 1940 and was destroyed. Beatties' car park occupies part of this site today.



Above: Looking down Grange Road Birkenhead in 1935, Irwins Grocers shop is on the left next to what was once FW Woolworths. The white building beyond is the Birkenhead Co-op Society's new premises which opened in this year on the site of the Hippodrome Theatre.



Above: 1937 The Arrowe Park Hotel which replaced the Horse & Jockey Inn at the junction of Upton Road and Church Lane, **Woodchurch**.



Above: 1928. **The Red Lion Hotel** which faced the village green in Willaston, became a public house in the early 1800's, although a date stone places the building back to at least 1631. It ceased being a public house in 1928.



Left: **Willaston's** chemist shop, was owned by Miss Lanceley until Duncan Kaye took the business over in 1948 and a year later built a new house behind.



We are an urban eco-friendly farm on Holmwood Drive Barnston, Wirral dedicated to the welfare of all our animals, with a free range approach. Neil Stuart has been running the farm for 2 and half years, each day was a struggle financially to make sure the welfare of the animals was as it should be. Steve's Story

We are reaching out for Steve, a Wirral man who was diagnosed with Primary Progressive Multiple Sclerosis (PPMS) in 2009 at the age of 50. Since his diagnosis he has gone from being a family man, loving husband, great friend to many who was always active, kept fit and a keen rambler up Snowdon to a man who is battling this life changing, debilitating disease. It has rapidly stolen not only his life but also the family life he once cherished and took for granted. He is now unable to walk at home without the use of a frame, go outdoors without the use of a wheelchair, suffers with permanent fatigue, brain fog, bowel and bladder issues and is unable to hold a conversation for any length of time.


Recently through research we discovered that a treatment under the NHS, HSCT (Haemeotopathic Stem Cell Treatment) was being carried out at Kings Hospital, London. This treatment is not a cure but is aimed at halting the disease in its tracks with a bonus of recovering degrees of disability. Unfortunately, Steve does not meet the criteria to have the treatment on the NHS. He does however meet the criteria to be treated at a private clinic in Mexico. We have researched this treatment extensively and with a 95% success rate there is no question it is Steve's only option of fighting the disease before further deterioration which may then exclude him from the clinic treatment in Mexico.

This treatment comes at a cost of \$54,500 including accommodation for the 28 day treatment period, excluding flights and an additional cost of 5 post treatment infusions in the UK. We have therefore set a goal to raise £50,000 to cover the cost and additional expenditure. In the first ten weeks we have managed to raise a magnificent £27,000. 

sweet and sour pork



Ingredients:

1/2 lb. pork tenderloin (cut into bite size pieces)
1/2 green bell pepper (2 oz. and cut into pieces)
1/2 red bell pepper (2 oz. and cut into pieces)
2 stalks scallions
(only the white part, cut into 2 inch length)
1 piece fresh/canned pineapple ring
(cut into small pieces)
1 clove garlic (finely chopped)
Oil for frving

Marinate:

1 teaspoon soy sauce 1/2 teaspoon corn starch 1/2 teaspoon rice wine

Sweet and Sour Sauce:

1 1/2 tablespoons tomato ketchup
1 teaspoon plum sauce
1/8 teaspoon Chinese rice vinegar (transparent in color)
1/2 teaspoon Lea & Perrins Worcestershire Sauce
1 teaspoon oyster sauce
1 teaspoon corn starch
1 teaspoon sugar
2 tablespoons water

Frying Batter:

1/2 cup water 2 oz. all-purpose flour 1 oz. corn starch 1/2 teaspoon baking soda

1/2 egg

1 teaspoon cooking oil 1 small pinch of salt

Method:

Cut the pork tenderloin into pieces and marinate with the ingredients for 15-20 minutes.

Mix the sweet and sour sauce ingredients well and set aside.

Strain the dry ingredients of the frying batter and then add in the egg, water, and cooking oil to form a thick batter.

When the pork is well-marinated, transfer the pork pieces into the batter and make sure they are well coated. In a deep skillet, add in the cooking oil enough for deep-frying. Once the oil is hot, deep fry the pork pieces until they turn golden brown. Dish out and drain on paper towels.

Heat up a wok and add in some cooking oil. Add in the chopped garlic and stir fry until light brown, then follow by the bell peppers and pineapple pieces. Stir fry until you smell the peppery aroma from the peppers and then add in the sweet and sour sauce. As soon as the sauce thickenens, transfer the pork into the wok and stir well with the sauce. Add in the chopped scallions, do a few quick stirs, dish out and serve hot with steamed white rice.

What to do in the Garden in January

In frosty weather little can be done in the garden. The ground is too hard to dig or plant and the lawn should not be walked

English Countryside Winter Scene

Despite the low temperatures and short daylight hours, there some useful tasks that can be done. If the weather is mild, you can still plant roses and bare rooted shrubs and trees. At this is time of year a heated greenhouse has great appeal, especially when the weather is too cold and wet to work outside. The warmth of a heated cold-frame or greenhouse or even a sunny indoor window enables you to sow annuals that need a long growing season and start of those early vegetable crops. Roots of favourite herbs, can also be lifted and brought indoors, to provide fresh shoots and leaves for winter flavour.



Winter digging is necessary for beds and borders that need to be planted in early spring. The earlier this is done the better, allowing time for frosts to act and break down the soil. The longer any rough clods of soil are exposed to frost, the easier it will be to get a fine tilth in spring. While digging, it is a good idea to work in plenty of well-rotted manure or garden compost at the same time, thus improving the soil's texture and richness.



on. Although there is very little work to do, January ushers in the beginning of a new year that is full of promise in the garden.

If you have planted any trees or shrubs during the winter months, check that they haven't been lifted by frost. Once lifted, they can rock in the wind and their roots will be slower to get established. Re-firm the plants by pressing down on the surrounding soil with your feet. You may also need to stake any tall or exposed plants to prevent further wind rock.

If the surface of water features or a pond has frozen solid, and particularly if it contains fish, break the ice with care. If the ice is very thick, use a little boiling water rather than a hammer, to avoid shock waves which can kill the creatures beneath.

Planning Next Seasons Garden

The long winter evenings provide plenty of time to browse through seed catalogues and plan new projects in the garden. Late January to early February is an ideal time to visit garden centres to buy seeds, tubers and bulbs for the coming season. If you are ordering products from a seed catalogue, or over the internet, it should be done as early as possible or they may arrive too late for their proper sowing or planting dates.



Maintain and Check Garden Tools and Equipment

Make sure that mechanical equipment such as mowers, rotovators, edgers, strimmers and hedge trimmers are in good working order. If any need repairing or sharpening, take them in for servicing by a professional.
