



Keeping you motoring

Renegade 2.0 MultiJet II 140hp Limited - 4WD 9-Speed Automatic



If you said to a group of your friends you were thinking about buying a 'Jeep' - most of them would immediately say 'why are you buying something the Army used to use' and you would then need to spend the rest of your life telling them that we no longer live in 1943 and that the Jeep you are referring to is a modern vehicle for the modern motorist.

So when I was recently offered the chance to give the New Jeep Renegade the full work down I was more than happy to oblige.

Power and Efficiency:

The Renegade was fitted with a140bhp 2.0 MultiJet II diesel engine that is punchy, brisk and actually quite refined - which is partly thanks to the 350Nm of torque it has available. The engine also feels very much alive and this has only added to the excitement of driving the Renegade.

Top speed is 113mph along with a decent 0-62 time

of around 10sec. Fuel economy is also rather good considering its size – and on the combined cycle I achieved 47.2mpg which was actually mostly done on urban roads.

On the road:

The Renegade was also fitted with a 9-Speed Automatic gearbox with the addition of 4WD functionality. On the tarmac it actually feels really good, and on the farm tracks on the outskirts of Staffordshire, it just kept on going and there really was very little to complain about.

Remember, this is not a Range Rover, but it does have an ability to do on and off-road rather well and I was really impressed. Although I fear most Renegade owners will never actually take their car off-road. I am going to say though that I found the ride to be a little too soft, but the Renegade happily gets a move on when the need arises and on the motorway it was reasonably quiet, so I am happy to forgive it for not being completely perfect.

Design & Technology:

The Renegade for some may not be the prettiest looking car – but it does offer fun and functionality –

which is what 'Jeep' ownership is all about.

Then again, you will either love or hate its quirky looks. Yes, it is a bit boxy and in your face, which was the first impression I got when it arrived on my drive - although my views soon changed and I have grown to like it quite a lot actually.

Some of standard equipment on the Renegade comes in the form of: Ambient Light (LED), forward collision warning-plus mitigation and Lanesense™, plus Lane departure warning, rear parking sensors, all speed traction control, Start & Stop, 6 Speaker audio system, 6 Airbags, Dual zone climate control, Premium instrument cluster with 7" colour TFT display, Uconnect 6.5" DAB radio with touchscreen, satellite navigation and Bluetooth ® and cruise control.

To sum up:

The Renegade is not a one size fits all – but saying that neither is a pair of trousers.

WALK 20 PUB WALKS WIRRA

The Hinderton Arms, Hinderton




Hadlow Road Station - The Wirral Way -**Hinderton - Willow Brow Road - Street Hev** Road - The Wirral Way - Willaston. Walking distance (6 1/2 miles).

Leave the old station, crossing Hadlow Road into The Wirral Way. Follow the path as it runs between fields that show a cross section of Wirral's farming activities. After walking for about 15 minutes you pass under Damhead Lane Bridge and, a short distance further on, the Way leads you underneath a cattle bridge continue forward and very soon you will pass over a wooden bridge that spans Cuckoo Lane. From here the Way winds through some trees until you reach another bridge, here vou

leave the Way and turn right into the picnic area. When you reach Lees Lane, go right to reach the A540. Here go to the left for a short time until you reach the Hinderton Arms.

This land was once owned by the Earl of Shrewsbury (that is where the former pub name of the Shrewsbury Arms comes from). Originally a farmhouse, although on a map dated 1810 it is named the Hinderton Inn - more apt perhaps as it dominates the Hinderton crossroads! A warm welcome and delicious food awaits you!

When leaving the pub, cross the Chester High Road into Ouarry Road. This is a pleasant winding lane, passing an old stone water tower to reach a bend in the road where 'Roselea' a large house stands, bear left here into a wide track between hedgerows and walk for about 10 minutes until you reach Willow Brow Road. Turn right and you will reach Willaston Road where your direction is left. Follow this road for about 1/4 mile, when the road bends to the left, look right for a signposted and well defined pathway leading into the trees. Following the track you will come across two small ponds. cross a stream and after about 10 minutes walk arrive in open countryside.

Look left for a great view of Willaston's old windmill built in 1800, this was the largest flour mill in Wirral and was in use until 1930 until a vicious storm destroyed the sails.

Carry on forward until your path meets another, here the way is right. After 100 yards turn left over stone steps and a two-bar stile to enter the fields. Cross, keeping a straight course with the hedge on your left. Cross 3 fields, using the stiles and wooden plank bridge. When you leave the third field, cross the footbridge and turn right into the trees. A well defined bridle path (can be very muddy after heavy rain) winds it's way through the trees to Street Hey Lane, ending at Hooton Road. Enter Heath Lane, straight ahead, walking along this quiet tree lined road for 1/2 mile until you reach the stone bridge over the Wirral Way. Turn right into the Way and follow the path as it leads through beautiful countryside leading back to the car park at Hadlow Station. It is worth having a look around the station as it has been kept as original as possible, looking like it did over 60 years ago!







Cod Parmesan with Zucchini Noodles

Serves: 4

Prep time: 15 minutes Cook time: 20 minutes

2 medium zucchini (5-6 ounces each), thinly sliced

1 tablespoon unsalted butter

teaspoon olive oil, salt and pepper, to taste

1/4 cup freshly grated Parmesan cheese

1 1/2 tablespoons mayonnaise

1 teaspoon lemon juice 1/8 teaspoon dried basil

1/8 teaspoon dried oregano

1/8 teaspoon onion powder

4 cod fillets (4-6 ounces each)

2 tablespoons shredded Parmesan cheese, divided

In nonstick skillet, saute zucchini slices in butter and oil just until soft. Add salt and pepper, to taste. Keep warm.

Heat oven to broil setting. Mix grated Parmesan cheese, mayonnaise, lemon juice, basil, oregano and onion powder together. Add salt and pepper, to taste. Divide and spread topping onto the top of each fillet.

Place fillets on foil-lined broiler pan. Broil 5-7 inches from broiler element for 3 minutes, or until top is browned and bubbly. Reduce heat to 300 F and cook 3-5 more minutes. Cook until fish is opaque throughout.

To serve, place 1/4 of zucchini on each plate. Top with cod fillet and garnish with 1/2 tablespoon shredded cheese.

Right: 1937. Birkenhead Tramcar No 22 has been illuminated for this last sad day of the tram era which date back to when Europe's first public tram system started in Birkenhead 1860. This illumination tramcar had been used to celebrate the Coronation earlier in 1937 and had been retained for this final role. Owen Murphy the oldest driver who started with the horse-drawn tramcars of the Victorian era was chosen for this final role. The sign on the side of the tram reads "Other Days - Other Ways".



Above: 1945. Right This Leyland Lion PLSCI Reg No. HF4535 (Fleet No 8) started with the **Wallasey** bus fleet in 1927 and was withdrawn in 1941. In 1945 it was converted into an illuminated bus and is seen here commemorating the end of the war. It was also used for other events including the Festival of Britain in 1951 and the Coironation in 1953. It was sold to Morris and Pulford in 1954 and used as a contractors site office.



Bottom Left: 1924. The Old Mill Cafe & Stores, known locally for many decades as Lumsden's Cafe, they held dances here two or three times a week. The land and buildings were purchased in 1938 by Higson's Brewery but the site was not developed due to planning permission being refused. However, eventually planning

permission was granted in teh 1970's but on condition that the cottage should be saved and any extensions in keepingwith the existing property. The Mill Pub was opened in 1980.



WESTERN APPROACHES WAR ROOMS

Birkenhead Rotarians and guests visited the Western Approaches War Rooms in Liverpool and saw the restored wartime bunker during a guided tour.

Situated underground next to Liverpool Town Hall, the secret bunker was where the Western Approaches Command controlled the allied forces during the Battle of the Atlantic in World War 2. Almost entirely staffed by young WRNS, aged between 17 and 25, who excelled in maths, the bunker played a huge part in winning WW2.

The bunker was built in Derby House, which became known locally as the "Citadel" or "Fortress" due to the extensive reinforced concrete protection given to the basement. It was bomb proof and gas proof, with a 7 foot thick roof and 3 foot deep walls, and 100 rooms covering 50,000 square feet.

The visitors viewed documents and equipment the forces used to monitor enemy convoys and inform the British government of their findings, whilst keeping their intelligence secret from the enemy, including one of only two surviving wartime phones which had a direct connection to the war cabinet in London.

Also on view was where commanders, WRNS and WAAF personnel worked every day and night in the Map Room, the nerve centre of the Battle of the Atlantic. Here they



monitored convoy routes and vital shipping lines, and pin-pointed enemy locations on a huge map.

The tour formed one of many vocational visits presented by Birkenhead Rotary, with the next event being a walk to Hilbre Island – weather permitting!.





The residents of a Wirral care home have proven 'you're never too old to learn how to use an iPad' after taking part in technology tutorial sessions.

The Hazelwell, a residential, nursing, palliative and respite care home in Heswall, have started hosting one-to-one sessions with residents which involves teaching them how to use the various features and functions of a tablet.

Rather than flicking through old photo albums or reading newspapers, they are happy swiping through their pictures on the tablets and tapping on the internet to keep up with the latest news.
