





Tenants will be given more rights when changes to the Landlord and Tenant Act 1985 are made on 20 March 2019. People who rent will be able to sue their landlords if their homes are not up to scratch. Issues with damp, noise, ventilation, repairs, drainage, infestations and facilities for cooking are a number of the issue's tenants will be able to take action on. It will cover tenants immediately and not just for new tenancies, existing tenancies will be covered. These changes mean that those in social housing will now have more power to force local authorities to carry out necessary repairs.

It is estimated that over 1 million rented homes have hazards that pose a serious risk. The new changes will mean that tenants will be able to take their landlord to court for an injunction to compel the landlord to carry out the works or for damages (compensation) for the landlord's failure to keep the property in good repair.

Compensation can also be paid to tenants for any issues that have caused injury or illness.

Review by Tony

Keeping you motoring

Honda HR-V 1.5 i-VTEC - S



When you first see the HR-V you will start to think 'is it a coupe or an SUV'. That's exactly what I thought when It arrived on my driveway, but I have been told that Honda wanted it to have the lines of a coupe, but also the robustness of an SUV and to be honest they seem to have pulled that off rather well and now the HR-V is one of the better-looking SUV's currently on the market.

Power and Efficiency:

The 1.5 Litre i-VTEC has 130PS and 155Nm of torque which is good and all thanks to Honda doing such a wonderful job of getting the best out of this fantastic little petrol engine that is so far, this year, one of the better ones I have come across for its size. I am also happy to report that the engine feels very refined and has bags of torque available when you need it most which makes motorway driving easy, quiet and unfussy.

The HR-V will also return a combined 42.8 MPG if driven with a very light right foot - and the emissions came in at a very respectable 130 g/ km. Top speed will also stop at around 119mph and 0-62 will come in at around 10.2 seconds.

On the road:

The HR-V does not feel heavy or cumbersome at all - and you can sense that Honda has put in a lot of effort in setting up the suspension and chassis to help deal with the many different surfaces the HR-V will come across in its lifetimebe that the morning school run or that camping trip away with the family.

Design & Technology:

The interior is of a good standard and its controls are well set out and all the dials are clear. I did not like the driver's seat as I found I just couldn't get the seating position perfect for me – but then I am quite fussy. Space inside is also good – better than most, and you could easily fit in a very large amount of luggage.

Plus – everything inside the HR-V feels well put together because it's a Honda and you know it will last till the end of time. Passenger legroom is also fine, as is the boot space with a seat up capacity of (431 litres) and seats folded flat capacity of (1456 litres).

Standard equipment on the S model includes; LED daytime running lights, Honda Connect with Garmin navigation, parking sensors, heated seats, LED headlights, smart keyless entry & start, rearview camera, brake assist, DAB radio with USB and Bluetooth connectivity, automatic climate control and cruise control with speed limiter The list does not stop there either – you also get; magic seats, power windows, ISO fix points, alarm & immobilizer system, hill start assist and vehicle stability assist.

To sum up:

A good buy – If you are searching for one of the best looking compact SUV's currently on the market with the addition of some good specification even in basic trim - and enough space to keep any large family happy, then the HR-V could be the perfect fit for you.



What to do in the Garden in April

April's here and spring has sprung at last! As the weather warms and early flowers start to bloom, all of a sudden it feels like there's plenty to do in the garden again.

Timely tips



Start with these four garden tasks this month:

Order your summer bedding and hanging basket plants online now - it's your last chance!

Give your greenhouse a thorough scrub (if you haven't already) with hot soapy water. This will get rid of pests and diseases and let in more light.

Prepare beds for the growing season. Dig in a 5cm (or more) layer of compost or well-rotted manure. You can also work in a general-purpose fertiliser, such as pelleted chicken manure, or fish, blood and bone.

Check your container plants aren't drying out - the warmer weather will quickly affect soil moisture levels.

In the flower garden



Here's what to be getting on with in the flower garden this month:

This month, there's plenty to sow and grow. But there's plenty more to do besides sowing and planting out. Here are your main garden jobs this April.

- Lift and divide perennial plants now, to improve vigour and create new plants for your garden.
- · Divide hostas before they come into leaf.
- Pinch out the tips of fuchsia shoots and sweet pea plants, to encourage bushy plants this summer.
- Divide primroses once they have finished flowering.
- Move evergreen shrubs and trees now, provided the soil isn't frozen or waterlogged.
- Feed trees, shrubs and hedges with a balanced, slow-release fertiliser, by lightly forking it into the soil surface.
 Roses, in particular, are greedy plants and will greatly benefit from feeding as they come into growth.
- Tie in climbing and rambling roses.
- Check any tree ties to make sure they're not cutting into the trunk. Loosen any that are tight, to allow the trunk some room to expand.
- Prune your penstemons now cut back all the old shoots to the base, provided there is new growth at the bottom of the plant. If there are no new shoots at the base, cut just above the lowest set of leaves.
- Finish cutting back any dead foliage on perennials and ornamental grasses (if you haven't done so already), to make way for new growth.
- Prune forsythia as soon as they have finished flowering, cutting back to strong, young shoots.
- Trim winter-flowering heathers as the flowers disappear, to prevent plants becoming leggy.
- Tie in new honeysuckle and clematis stems. These plants will be putting on growth now, and you'll need to train them along their supports.
- Continue to remove faded flowers from winter pansies to stop them setting seed. This will encourage flushes of new flowers throughout the spring.
- Deadhead daffodils and tulips as the flowers finish, but leave foliage intact, allowing it to die back naturally.

So as you can see you will be quite busy!





Serves 4 (serving size: 1 cutlet and about 1/4 cup sauce)

Marsala cooking wine is a worthy addition to your pantry; it's dry and sweet without being overpowering, and can cut through the richness of cream or stock. The alcohol will cook off as the sauce simmers. Adding butter at the end, a classic technique, gives the sauce its body and gloss.

Ingredients

2 tablespoons olive oil, divided

4 (4-oz.) skinless, boneless chicken breast cutlets

3/4 teaspoon black pepper, divided

1/2 teaspoon kosher salt, divided

1 (8-oz.) pkg. presliced button mushrooms

4 thyme sprigs 1 tablespoon all-purpose flour

2/3 cup unsalted chicken stock

2/3 cup Marsala wine

2 1/2 tablespoons unsalted butter

1 tablespoon chopped fresh thyme (optional)

Serve this skillet main over polenta, mashed potatoes, or hot cooked brown rice. If you have leftover thyme, try steeping in chicken stock before making a risotto, tossing with roasted vegetables, or adding to a frittata.

How to Make It

Step 1

Heat 1 tablespoon oil in a large nonstick skillet over medium-high. Sprinkle chicken with 1/2 teaspoon pepper and 1/4 teaspoon salt. Add chicken to pan; cook until done, about 4 minutes per side. Remove chicken from pan (do not wipe out pan).

Step 2

Add remaining 1 tablespoon oil to pan.

Add mushrooms and thyme sprigs; cook, stirring occasionally, until mushrooms are browned, about 6 minutes.

Sprinkle flour over mixture; cook, stirring constantly, 1 minute.

Step 3

Add stock and wine to pan; bring to a boil. Cook until slightly thickened, 2 to 3 minutes. Remove pan from heat. Stir in butter, remaining 1/4 teaspoon pepper, and remaining 1/4 teaspoon salt. Add chicken to pan, turning to coat. Discard thyme sprigs before serving. Sprinkle with chopped thyme, if desired.






