

Tenants will be given more rights when changes to the Landlord and Tenant Act 1985 are made on 20 March 2019. People who rent will be able to sue their landlords if their homes are not up to scratch. Issues with damp, noise, ventilation, repairs, drainage, infestations and facilities for cooking are a number of the issue's tenants will be able to take action on. It will cover tenants immediately and not just for new tenancies, existing tenancies will be covered. These changes mean that those in social housing will now have more power to force local authorities to carry out necessary repairs.

It is estimated that over 1 million rented homes have hazards that pose a serious risk. The new changes will mean that tenants will be able to take their landlord to court for an injunction to compel the landlord to carry out the works or for damages (compensation) for the landlord's failure to keep the property in good repair.

Compensation can also be paid to tenants for any issues that have caused injury or illness.

You'll need to have information and evidence to help support your case. This includes:

- A copy of your tenancy agreement

- A list of or photographs of belongings that have been damaged because of the disrepair and copies of receipts if you had to replace damaged items
- Copies of medical reports or a note of medical visits if you were injured or made ill by the disrepair.





Romantic Naples, just two hours south of Rome, is the largest city in southern Italy. It has some of the world's best opera houses and theatres, and is often called an open-air museum, because of its many historic statues and monuments. Join families on promenade as the sun sets on the Bay of Naples. View finds from Pompeii and Herculaneum, destroyed by Mount Vesuvius in A.D. 79, at the Museo Archeologico Nazionale or revel in the art and architecture of Museo Cappella Sansevero, built in the late 1500s.

Visiting a city such as Naples means, of course, a diverse schedule of sightseeing; exploring its museums, art galleries, and nicest streets for strolling. While a week would do this phenomenal city more justice, one day is still enough to get lost in the alleys of its Spanish quarters (and observe the genuine life of the Neapolitans), enjoy a fantastic pizza, and relax in a prestigious coffee spot such as Gambrinus. Pizza, one of Italy's most famous foods, originated in Naples and pizza is taken very seriously here. You'll find lots of great pizza places but be sure you look for one with a wood-burning oven!

Eggplant Parmesan originated in Naples and spaghetti also became popular in Naples, try it with clams or mussels. Seafood is abundant and very good in Naples.

Naples gets quite hot in summer so spring and fall are probably the best times to visit. Since Naples is near the coast, it's more temperate in winter than interior cities of Italy.

As you are only in Naples for 1 whole day from the ship, enjoy the other great places such as your stay in Barcelona.

See the best of Barcelona on a private sightseeing tour, which offers a comprehensive view of this exquisite Catalan city and includes skip-the-line access at La Sagrada Familia, a popular attraction that often has long lines. ## Autoreview by Tony Yates

Keeping you motoring

Hyundai Santa Fe Premium SE - 2.2 CRDi - 8 Speed Auto- 4WD.(200PS)



#### **Power and Efficiency:**

Fitted with a 2,199cc turbocharged diesel engine with 200PS @ 3,800rpm and 440Nm of torque @ 1,750 - 2,750rpm. 0-62mph is around 9.3sec, and fuel consumption is a decent 44.8 mpg combined with a top speed of 127mph.

Now, I know we all think large engines are a thing of the past – but we are all wrong. How do I know that – well Hyundai has proved that a large diesel engine can be just as efficient – and I think they are right, as the 2.2-litre engine in the 'New Generation' Santa Fe is an excellent choice as it goes well and sounds great. Its also quite refined actually with no signs of shake, rattle and roll.

At the end of the day, it all comes down to balancing the mechanical efficiency and power of this engine - which I hope helps it stand out above some of the other not so efficient units on the market. Plus,

remember the Santa Fe is a car that can be used to move large amounts of stuff around with ease.

#### On the road:

Actually, it's pretty nimble for such a large car – but it can't be classed as 'frisky' if I'm being honest. Take the Santa Fe out on the open road though, and you soon begin to feel just how well it grips. Of course, manufacturers spend an awful amount of money designing and developing the chassis and suspension, because they want it to be the best it can be. But sometimes there are compromises to be made. Well after just a few hours driving, I realised the Santa Fe is a great buy.

#### **Design & Technology**

I don't want to speak out of turn here, but the Santa Fe really is a handsome thing – Yes, it won't suit everyone – and I should know as I own a VW UP! – which is not the prettiest of things I grant you, but, then again - I don't think the latest Land Rover Discovery is particularly 'good looking' either - but people will still spend lots of their cash buying one.

Also, when I do any road tests out on the open road, I follow a pretty simple set of rules - its either 'good or bad or very bad'. Well, I'm happy to report that Santa Fe is firmly aligned with the word 'Good'. So, there you have it, another decent car with some faults such as an interior which is not on my favourite list, but its still functional.

The 'New Generation' Santa Fe also benefits from a superior rigidity through the use of advanced high strength steel and high impact energy absorption that protects passengers in the event of a collision. There are also six airbags: two front airbags, two side airbags and two curtain airbags from first to the second row, protecting both driver and passengers. All safe & sound there then.

Standard equipment on the Santa Fe Premium SE starts with; 8" Touchscreen Sat-Nav, 19" Alloy Wheels,

Front Seats, LED Headlights, Heated Steering Wheel, KRELL Premium Audio with 10 Speakers including External Amplifier and Subwoofer, Rear Cross Traffic Alert, Leather Seat Trim, Smart Keyless Entry and a whole host of other extras. I'm not kidding here, the list is so long - that it actually boggles the mind.

#### To sum up:



Summer - the time for recreation and holidays. But before you leave for your summer holidays, we have a couple of tips on what to do in your midsummer garden.

#### **CUTTING STRONG GROWING HEDGES**

To make sure that hedges grow densely and evenly, they should be cut several times a year. After the main breeding period of birds from March to late July, you can start cutting your hedges again.

#### **SHAPE YOUR BOXWOODS**

To preserve the details of boxwood trees or bushes which were cut in shape, you should now cut back your boxwoods and other evergreens. For perfect shapes you can create templates from cardboard.

#### PRUNING LAVENDER

When lavender has mostly finished flowering, the shoots should be reduced approximately by one third. This prevents the lavender plants from investing too much energy into seed production. The following year, your lavender will be back with a strong bloom.

#### REMOVE DEAD FLOWERS

Removing wilted flowers is not only done for aesthetic reasons, but also supports the formation of new flowering shoots. The plant can concentrate its power to the fresh flowers. Moreover, the dead flowers will not become a breeding ground for pests or fungi. Some summer shrubs like larkspur, produce flowers a second time in autumn, when they are cut back after the main flowering.

#### FIRST AID FOR SUNFLOWERS

If your sunflowers did not come through the latest summer storm, the final chapter has not yet been written. With first aid for sunflowers, you can save even turned down stems. Put the fracture in a splint made of bamboo sticks and fix it with duct tape. This way the water supply is guaranteed.



#### **SOW FRESH SEEDS ON VACATED PATCHES**

In August the gardening year is almost over. Some vegetables, however, can still be sown without any problems at the now-vacated patches. These include Radishes, Lettuce, Rocket, Winter Onions and Spinach.



#### **DIVIDE SHRUBS**

Should the flowering of your shrubs get weaker or should the blossoms get bald inside, it's time to give your summer shrubs a rejuvenating cure by dividing them. August is a good month for dividing spring and summer flowering shrubs. Dig the shrubs out with a spade or a fork and divide the plants into parts. The single parts should be at least as big as a fist. Remove sick and withered root parts as well as bald spots. Planted at suitable locations the shrubs will return in full blossom.

#### FRIENDS OF HADLOW STATION UPDATE

Relaying the rail track has now been completed. This has come in at a total cost of around  $\pounds 9{,}500.$ 

This cost covers all the new sleepers, plus the new pieces of rail track and rail fittings that extends alongside the signal box, the ballast, and also the direct expenses incurred by Real Skills Training for getting their apprentices to/from Hadlow Road Station, etc, whilst the apprentices labour was provided free of charge. This has been a huge undertaking and much bigger than we realised when we started but we feel that the end product is well worth the effort put in by our superb maintenance team led by Tim and will last for another 40+ years all being well.

You will notice that more memorabilia signs have been installed around the station, (renovated and fitted by Andy). There is one inside the far shelter and also two "Way out" signs on the main platform. See if you can spot them.

Three more Rowan trees have been planted on the green space embankment behind the signal box to go alongside the two trees kindly donated and planted by Willaston Hey W.I.

Existing flagstones on this section of the platform have been cleared (which is now much easier to walk along). A cost of £3,420 will be incurred to put edging stones down that match the far platform so budget prioritisation will need to be undertaken including agreement on how to spend the very kind £600 donation from South Wirral Rambling Club.

Garden maintenance has started up again now that the weather is improving and there are a lot of spring flowers showing. These will be supplemented with the £45 National Garden Gift Card donation received from Chester & North Wales Cyclists' Touring Club (Weds Group).



The Pop-up-cafe continues to be a great success thanks to your support, and the very hard work of all the catering team in planning and organising the food purchasing supported by other volunteers on serving duties when the pop-up café is open on Sundays.

The next pop-up cafe openings will be April 28th from 10.30am to 1.30pm.

We look forward to your continuing support and seeing you all once again.



### Interior design student's top tips for a dementia friendly home

### KETTLEDESIGN

PLANNING - ENCHITECTURE - DESIGN - DECORATION

A 21-year-old interior design student from Liverpool is using her skills to help people who have been diagnosed with dementia.

Hannah Martin, who is in her final year of an Interior Design degree at The University of Huddersfield, was inspired after working on her final year project about designing dementia friendly spaces and seeing a family member struggle with the disease.

Dementia is an umbrella term for a number of progressive conditions that affect the brain, which include Alzheimer's disease and vascular dementia. It can affect a person at any age and there are more than 850,000 people living with dementia in the UK. This is set to rise to over one million by 2021.

Hannah is on a placement year at award-winning technical interior design company Kettle Design in Heswall and is now helping to advise clients on how to make a home dementia friendly. She will join the company full time when she graduates this summer. Hannah said: "My final year project has focused all around creating dementia friendly spaces in the home. As part of my research, I've visited a number of dementia care homes, talked to nurses and

also spent time with dementia patients and their

"It can also become a huge hazard for them if it has not been designed well. That's why it's so important to rethink the space to ensure that it is as comfortable as possible for them and also their families and carers.

"I wanted to use my interior design skills to design a dementia friendly space to help other people in their homes to make their life easier.

"There are big structural changes such as installing a lift, adding disability access ramps, putting rails around the house and making a disabled bathroom. But there are lots of little clever interior desion solutions that can help

too, from considering what colours are used in the home to affect their mood to avoiding dark surfaces on the floor which can look like a hole to someone with dementia.

### Here are Hannah's tips for a dementia friendly

#### Think about colour

Iry and ensure that colours are pleasing to the eye as colours can have a big impact on the mood of someone with dementia. Reds are usually associated with danger, but for a dementia patient, red is stimulating and can be effectively used in an activity space to keep them motivated and mentally active. Blues, greens and violet tones are calming tones that are also aesthetically pleasing. They are good to use in a bedroom. Yellow tones are bright, warm and happy colours and suited to a kitchen or living room.

#### **Embrace contrasts**

Colours need to contract to ensure visibility within spaces. Contrasting walls and floors, tables and chairs, even sets of plates and bowls, ensures that everything is noticeable and recognisable as their eyesight and visibility decreases. Contrasting also helps people with dementia to become aware of their surroundings and know where to go. Contrast the colour of light switches with the wall, so they can be easily seen. You can also use contrasting colours for furniture but avoid stripes.

#### Be careful with flooring

Having one overall flooring surface is crucial in designing a dementia friendly interior. People with dementia are easily confused and distressed. Having one floor surface means they do not get muddled and think they are tripping or stepping on something they shouldn't. A straight clean passageway through

a space is important. Dark coloured floors should always be avoided as dark surfaces on a floor or kitchen top can resemble a hole. Avoid shiny floors as they can look wet, blue floors can look like water while green floors can be confused for grassy surfaces. Keeping a natural coloured surface such as wooden floor is perfect.

#### Warm lighting

Lighting determines a space and the time of day, and having bright warm lights can create a safe and warm environment. People with dementia often become confused about what time of day it is so keeping a space bright – using brighter lightbulbs and dimmer switches - throughout the day is crucial to keeping them active and awake. By contrast, dark spaces can make them think it's night time and make them sleepy. Check that curtains and blinds are not blocking any natural light from a room.

#### Consider signage

Signs are important to make people aware of different areas within a space. Try labelling doors and walls to help guide the person through a space and remind them of where they are. Have bold, effective signs and make sure they are at eye-level height. You can also stick pictures on the front of cupboards to remind the person what is inside – for example, a picture of cutlery on the cutlery drawer, a picture of clothes on the door of a wardrobe.

#### **Beware of mirrors**

Mirrors can be upsetting to a person with dementia as they may not recognise the person in the reflection as being themselves. Clear materials, mirrors and reflective surfaces can also be mistaken as not being there so can be a hazard. It may be best to remove them completely.

### Parkinson's disease and EXERCISE

11th of April was World Parkinson's Day.
Most of us have heard about Parkinson's, but only a few of us know what it is exactly, and how it affects people living with the condition. One out of 450 individuals has Parkinson's, which means that on the Wirral alone around 7000 people live with it.

Parkinson's disease is a progressive neurological condition; it causes problems in the brain and gets worse over time. People with Parkinson's disease don't produce enough of the chemical called dopamine, because some of the nerve cells that are responsible for its production have died. What causes the death of these cells is still not known.

Dopamine acts like a messenger between the brain and the muscles, but if its presence is decreased, the body won't function as it should. There are 3 main symptoms of Parkinson's disease- tremor (shaking), slowness of movement and rigidity (muscle stiffness) - but there are many other symptoms too.

Unfortunately there is currently no cure for Parkinson's, but there are ways to better manage symptoms and improve quality of life. Scientific research has proven that exercise can be highly beneficial. Interestingly enough, the more vigorous the exercise, the greater the benefits it carries!

A program called Rock Steady Boxing (RSB) has been developed over the last 15 years in Indianapolis, USA. It is boxing-based, but completely non-contact, so the only thing Rock

Steady boxers punch is the heavy bag and the disease itself! These classes have proven that anyone, at any level of Parkinson's, can lessen their symptoms and lead a healthier and happier life

Parkinson's causes a loss in many of the same elements that boxers condition to improve. These include agility, speed, muscular endurance, accuracy, balance, hand-eye coordination, footwork and overall strength to defend against and overcome opponents. At Rock Steady the opponent is Parkinson's disease.

In comparison with other sports, boxing is one of the most physically demanding styles of training, and also an incredible stress reliever, confidence booster and **FUN!** Working out in a group also enables people to meet with others in similar circumstances and share their experiences.

RSB classes now run every Saturday at the Wirral and Chester Taekwondo Academy. It is suitable for all ages and abilities; our current fighters are between the ages of 50-80 years! If you, or a loved one is affected by Parkinson's, come and see for yourself the difference Rock Steady Boxing is making to people's lives.

#### **Pilot study will** improve employment prospects for ex-Service personnel with health conditions

Ex-Service personnel who are being assisted with physical and mental health issues will also be offered intensive employment support in a pioneering pilot by The Poppy Factory. funded by The Forces in Mind Trust.

Delivered in partnership with Cheshire and Wirral Partnership NHS Foundation Trust (CWP), the three year study in Wirral will bring the employability charity's longestablished expertise supporting ex-Service personnel with health conditions into an NHS healthcare setting for the first time.

A highly experienced employability consultant from The Poppy Factory will be embedded in the NHS multidisciplinary team to deliver comprehensive employment support to ex-Forces men and women who are wounded, sick or injured.

The package, based on the principles of Individual Placement Support1 (IPS), takes each individual's physical health and mental health needs into account, with the aim of securing meaningful long-term employment.

It is intended that the study, which will be evaluated by the University of Nottingham, will reveal any gaps in knowledge and research, help improve existing services and forge closer



links between health providers and the Armed Forces charity sector.

The pilot is funded by The Forces In Mind Trust (FiMT), a £35 million funding scheme run by the FiMT using an endowment awarded by The National Lottery Community Fund. The £289.843 pilot will take place at the Stein Centre in St Catherine's Hospital in Birkenhead, Wirral, an area with one of the highest concentrations of ex-Service personnel in the country. It will see The Poppy Factory work closely with health and social care partners in the local area.

Ray Lock, Chief Executive, Forces in Mind Trust, said: "Knowledge and evidence should form the basis of any policy. FiMT's latest published research, by the Directory of Social Change, highlighted how the Armed Forces Charity sector is shrinking. underlining the need to encourage collaboration with statutory service providers.

"This unique study by The Poppy Factory has the opportunity to change how employment and health services are delivered to this small but vulnerable group of ex-Service personnel."

Deirdre Mills. Chief Executive of The Poppy Factory, said: "We are very grateful to The Forces in Mind Trust for supporting and funding this important pilot project, which brings the expertise we have developed in communities around the UK into a clinical healthcare setting for the first time.

"The study will enable us to help many more veterans with physical and mental health conditions fulfil their potential outside the Forces by moving back into meaningful and sustained employment."

Dr Anushta Sivananthan, Consultant **Psychiatrist and CWP Medical** Director, said: "We're delighted to be working with The Poppy Factory to meaningfully meet the needs of ex-service men and women in a person-centred way. Meaningful employment can be vital to people's social inclusion and this pioneering pilot will help shape the way our veterans can fulfil their potential."







## NO1 MASALA Recipe -INDIAN RESTAURANT & TAKEAWAY

# Chicken Madras



This simple family dinner is full of fragrant spices and tender pieces of chicken.

#### **Ingredients**

1 onion, peeled and quartered

2 garlic cloves

thumb-sized chunk of ginger, peeled

½ red chilli

1 tablespoon vegetable oil

½ tablespoon turmeric

1 tablespoon ground cumin

1 tablespoon ground coriander

1-2 tablespoon hot chilli powder (depending on how spicy you like your curry)

4 chicken breasts, cut into chunks

400g can chopped tomatoes small pack coriander, chopped rice, naan and mango chutney, to serve.

#### Method

- 1. Blitz 1 guartered onion, 2 garlic cloves, a thumbsized chunk of ginger and 1/2 red chilli together in a food processor until it becomes a coarse paste.
- 2. Heat 1 tablespoon vegetable oil in a large saucepan and add the paste, fry for 5 mins, until softened. If it starts to stick to the pan at all, add a splash of water.
- 3. Tip in  $\frac{1}{2}$  tablespoon turmeric. 1 tablespoon ground cumin. 1 tablespoon ground coriander and 1-2 tsp hot chilli powder and stir well, cook for a couple of mins to toast them a bit, then add 4 chicken breasts, cut into chunks, Stir and make sure everything is covered in the spice mix.
- 4. Cook until the chicken begins to turn pale, adding a small splash of water if it sticks to the base of the pan at all.
  - 5. Pour in 400g can chopped tomatoes, along with a big pinch of salt, cover and cook on a low heat for 30 mins. until the chicken is tender.
- 6. Stir through small pack of coriander and serve with rice, naan and a big dollop of mango chutney.




