Tenants will be given more rights when changes to the Landlord and Tenant Act 1985 are made on 20 March 2019. People who rent will be able to sue their landlords if their homes are not up to scratch. Issues with damp, noise, ventilation, repairs, drainage, infestations and facilities for cooking are a number of the issue's tenants will be able to take action on. It will cover tenants immediately and not just for new tenancies, existing tenancies will be covered. These changes mean that those in social housing will now have more power to force local authorities to carry out necessary repairs.

It is estimated that over 1 million rented homes have hazards that pose a serious risk. The new changes will mean that tenants will be able to take their landlord to court for an injunction to compel the landlord to carry out the works or for damages (compensation) for the landlord's failure to keep the property in good repair.

Compensation can also be paid to tenants for any issues that have caused injury or illness.



Keeping you motoring

Kia Stinger 'GT S' - 3.3 T-GDi



This week's review is so easy. What Kia has done here is made another perfect car that has an engine more powerful than you can possibly comprehend - plus the added option of being one of the most comfortable cars I have ever had the pleasure of sitting in. The Stinger is not only good - it's utterly brilliant. And, I'm not just saying that either - it really is stunning to drive.

Power and Efficiency:

The version I currently have on test is powered by a 3.3-litre turbocharged petrol engine with 361BHP and 510Nm of torque which makes the Stinger move along like a scalded Cat - and when you consider it's quite big in size - that makes it even more that little bit special.

So, big engine means bad fuel economy right? Well actually it's not that bad at all - and you can expect to achieve around 29.4.mpg (combined) plus, an eye wobbling top speed of 168mph. Of course, speed needs to be kept on the track, but the little secret of the Stinger is that it loves the idea of doing just that. Because It wants to race, it wants to win!

On the road:

The Stinger feels very good on all roads surfaces - and there are no dramas to talk about here because it's well balanced and settled even on some of our most demanding roads - meaning you will have less to worry about if you decide to start planting the Stinger briskly into the corners. I know I have said this time and time again - but the Kia engineers really do put a lot of effort into making their cars handle well and you can feel that in the way the Stinger tells you exactly what's going on beneath you – while Kia's onboard safety features do their job by keeping everything present and correct.

Safety and Technology

Trim levels on the inside of the Stinger are also lovely and everything was bathed in leather and chrome – but for me, the Stinger is a long-distance mile muncher and a car that is able to accommodate a large family and pretty much everything you can throw at it.

The interior is also well thought out with modern hard-wearing materials that will be very good at resisting wear and tear for many years. Plus it's fitted with more safety features to keep you and your family safe – which makes me feel all warm on the inside.

With technology now being one of the most important factors most people look for when buying a new car – the Stinger needed to offer a lot of toys. Well, I can happily report that the Stinger does not fall short here – and comes with a whole array of features such as;

19" Alloy Wheels, Dark Chrome Front Grill Surround, Tinted Glass, Projection Headlights, LED Headlights, LED Daytime Running Lights & LED Rear Tail Lights, Sliding & Reclining Front Seats, 9-speaker Audio System with front underseat subwoofer, 15-speaker Harman / Kardon® Premium Audio System with Subwoofer, External Amp & Front Centre Speaker, Customisable Head-Up Display (HUD), DAB Radio with MP3 Compatibility, Shark Fin Antenna, USB & AUX Ports for Connection of a Media Device, Rear USB Charging Port, Bluetooth® with Music Streaming, Electronic Controlled Suspension (ECS) and Brembo® Brakes.

Plus the list just keeps on going and I have run out of space this week. All I will say is trust me here readers, the list is long and it will cater to your every need.

To sum up: Go out right now and see for yourself what the Kia Stinger has to offer. What a brilliant car – and a massive 5 stars from me.





Blue Plaque unveiled at Wirral Waters to commemorate world famous civil engineer

The Lord Lieutenant of Merseyside, Mr Mark Blundell, accompanied by the Mayor of Wirral, Councillor Tony Smith, will unveil a very special Blue Plaque at the Canada Works at Wirral Waters this Friday (21st June).

The plaque will commemorate the life and achievements of Cheshire-born Thomas Brassey, one of the great unsung heroes of the railway age.

Thomas Brassey was arguably the most prolific builder of railways that the world has ever seen. By 1847, at the age of 42, he had built one third of the railways in the United Kingdom, including the Chester to Holyhead railway line, and by the time of his death, in 1870, he had built one in twenty miles of all the world's railways.

Thomas also built bridges, including the Saughall Massie bridge and the Penketh viaduct, and train stations, including Chester and Shrewsbury. In 1834, he built the new Chester Road in Bromborough and, in 1850, he built part of the Birkenhead Docks. In 1852, he was contracted to build the 540-mile Grand Trunk Railway in Canada and decided to build his works in Birkenhead. He named his premises Canada Works in honour of this vast Canadian undertaking.

Canada Works, along West Float, was at the leading edge of 'best in class' engineering innovation and fabrication, placing Birkenhead at the centre of a global operation. Over 300 locomotives were made and exported from Canada Works.

Brassey also achieved great things during the Crimean War. In 1854, the British Army and their French allies were facing annihilation, with no field hospitals or any means of getting supplies through. Brassey offered to build the 39 miles of railway from Balaclava to the front line at Sebastopol. Brassey and his loyal workforce, worked day and night and the line was finished in just sixteen weeks. Supplies started moving up to the front line with wounded men coming in the

opposite direction. In 1855, the British Army and their French allies, who were still being supplied by Brassey's men, were victorious.

Blue Plaques, once administered by English Heritage, are historical markers installed in public places to commemorate a link between that location and a famous person, event, or former building on the site.

Conservation Areas Wirral has introduced the Blue Plaque scheme to Wirral and is currently working with Wirral Council to erect four plaques a year to commemorate prominent Wirral citizens, events, buildings or achievements.

Thomas Brassey's family will be among the guests at the unveiling of the plaque along with David Millar, managing director of Heap and Partners Ltd at Canada Works Birkenhead, who will host a reception afterwards. The business's founder, William Heap, was Thomas Brassey's Bridge Master at the Canada Works from 1856 until 1866 and David Millar is only the fifth Managing Director of Heap and Partners since the company was founded in 1866.

David Allan, vice chairman of Conservation Areas Wirral, said: "The contribution of Thomas Brassey to the world's railways cannot be overestimated. He is up there along with Stephenson and Brunel. To erect a Blue Plaque to celebrate his work is an honour that is long overdue. To erect that plaque on a wall adjacent to his Birkenhead-based 'Canada Works' is more than an honour, it is a privilege."

Richard Mawdsley, director of development for Wirral Water at Peel Land and Property, said: "We are very proud to welcome such distinguished guests to Wirral Waters for the unveiling of such an important Blue Plaque. Thomas Brassey was a pioneer whose fantastic creations are still living and breathing all around us and we are looking forward to paying tribute to him in the presence of his family."





Crops to harvest in September

September, the month for bumper harvests - here are some crops to harvest this month.



September is the month for reaping the rewards of your labours – lots of crops, such as runner beans, potatoes and raspberries are ready to harvest. But you can also sow seeds for future harvests.

The weather in September is often warm, so you'll need to keep watering.

It's a time when you might have gluts of certain crops – find out about preserving your harvests.

Here are some jobs you can get on with on the allotment in September.

Harvest crops

Oodles of crops are ready to harvest in September, including onions, potatoes, runner beans, courgettes, autumn-fruiting raspberries, tomatoes, apples and the last of the runner beans.



Onion

Harvest after the leaves turn yellow and the stems bend over. Carefully lift the bulbs using a fork, and leave to dry in a warm, dry spot for two weeks before storing.

Discover how to store onions.





Runner beans

Pick beans regularly. If they are stringy, pick them when they are small and tender.



Autumn-fruiting raspberries

Autumn-fruiting raspberries can be picked up to the first frosts. Either enjoy fresh or freeze to enjoy during the winter.



INSTRUCTIONS

- Preheat your oven to 200°C. Put the water (amount specified in the ingredient list) on to boil in a large saucepan on medium heat. Add the vegetable stock pot and stir to dissolve. Remove the root and dark green tops from the leek, cut in half lengthways and thinly slice into half moons. Peel and grate the garlic (or use a garlic press). Halve, peel and finely chop the red onion into ½cm pieces.
- Add the **couscous** to your pan of stock, remove from the heat and pop on a lid. Set it aside until everything else is ready. Halve the **aubergine** lengthways and chop into 1cm pieces. Put on a baking tray, drizzle over some **olive oil** and season with a pinch of **salt**. Toss to coat then spread out evenly and roast on the top shelf of your oven until soft and brown. 20 mins.
- Put a splash of **olive oil** in a frying pan on medium-low heat.

 Add the **leek**, **garlic** and **onion**. Cook until soft, about 5 mins.

 Stir in the **tomato purée** and **tomato passata** and continue to cook on low heat until the **stew** begins to thicken. 5-10 mins.
- Add the green olives, a pinch of salt and a few grinds of black pepper to the stew. Once the aubergine is cooked, add that in too along with the ground almonds.
- Pick the **basil leaves** from their stalks and finely chop (discard the **stalks**). Take the lid off the couscous and fluff it up with a fork. Stir through three-quarters of the **basil**.
- Serve the **couscous** with the **aubergine stew** on top.
 Crumble over the **feta** and sprinkle on the remaining **basil**.




