Tenants will be given more rights when changes to the Landlord and Tenant Act 1985 are made on 20 March 2019. People who rent will be able to sue their landlords if their homes are not up to scratch. Issues with damp, noise, ventilation, repairs, drainage, infestations and facilities for cooking are a number of the issue's tenants will be able to take action on. It will cover tenants immediately and not just for new tenancies, existing tenancies will be covered. These changes mean that those in social housing will now have more power to force local authorities to carry out necessary repairs.

It is estimated that over 1 million rented homes have hazards that pose a serious risk. The new changes will mean that tenants will be able to take their landlord to court for an injunction to compel the landlord to carry out the works or for damages (compensation) for the landlord's failure to keep the property in good repair.

Compensation can also be paid to tenants for any issues that have caused injury or illness.



Review by Tony Yates

Keeping you motoring

Kia ProCeed 1.4 T-GDi 'GT-Line S' (7-speed auto DCT)



Well, Wimbledon is now over and for reasons I don't understand, were just about to get a new Prime Minister - who I'm told is going to do great things by fixing Brexit. And if that is not enough bad news for you today - then you will also be sad to learn that all the slugs in my garden keep attacking my vegetable plot. Please feel free to write the editor with any advice on how I can combat these pests.

Well thankfully, this weeks review also has some good news - in the form of the new Kia ProCeed. Firstly, the looks are stunning. Secondly, the new Kia ProCeed for me is an actual piece of art - and that's before we even get the what's under the skin. Well, without further interruption from them pesky slugs let's get on with it.

Power and Efficiency:

The GT-Line S version I currently have on the test was fitted with a 1.4 T-GDi petrol engine with

138bhp and 242Nm of torque. Ah!, now it all starts to make sense I hear you shout. And, as for the engine - this is simple to explain, I like this engine a lot and the fuel economy figures are even better than most coming in at around 42.8mpg (combined) and with a decent top speed of around the 127mph. OK, it's not the quickest 0-62 I have seen at 9.1 seconds - but. it's still a great engine all the same. My only gripe really is I wish it had a little bit more power. If they could maybe squeeze160BHP - that for me would help the new ProCeed feel that little bit more urgent. Don' get me wrong - it's not slow, in fact, it's pretty nippy for such a large car.

On the road:

Kia knows how to make a good chassis and that shows - because the ProCeed rides our roads in all its glory - while feeling very planted and managing all the bumps and potholes with utter

ease. There are also no dramas and it feels very well settled into the corners. The Kia engineers really have done a proper job getting the new ProCeed to handle well and you can feel exactly what the road is doing beneath you – while Kia's massive amount of onboard safety features will keep it all present and correct, even in the event you get it all wrong. This is a big plus point for me and where Kia always gets everything just right – by you giving more active driver aids which is a big plus point for anyone looking for a car that ticks all boxes.

Design and Technology:

The GT-Line S trim level is very good – and you can see where Kia has gone and done one better than most in the form of a sporty theme on the outside – which then also continues inside the cabin with good quality upholstery, along with very nice cabin materials that you would only expect to find in some higher priced models from the likes of BMW. In fact, I'm going to say that the inside of the ProCeed is lavish and well thought out and offers something extra – but without the extra price tag.

On the inside - you also get a lot of equipment such as; 18" Alloy Wheels, 8-speaker JBL Premium Sound System, DAB Radio, LED Daytime Running Lights (front & rear) LED full-width rear brake light, Smart Cruise Control, Blind-Spot Collision Warning, Lane Keeping Assist, High-Beam Assist, Intelligent Stop & Go, ESC, VSM, ABS, EBD & BAS. Plus, Hill-Start Assist Control, Drive Mode Select and Forward Collision Avoidance Assist.

The list, I have to say, covers the full side of an A4 sheet of paper – because there is so much. If I was you – I would visit your local Kia dealer right away and take a look at all the equipment you get as standard. Yes, it really is that staggering.

To sum up: Don't mess about - Buy one!

It looks amazing, it drives amazing and the equipment you get in the GT-Line S version is staggering.

CAMRA WIRRAL PUB TRAIL

BEBINGTON STATION - PORT SUNLIGHT - EASTHAM FERRY -Eastham Village - Bromborough, 5 Contrasting Pubs. 6.5 Miles Along Roads and Country Footpaths Suitable For Walkers and Cyclists.





Start at the *Railway* on the Port Sunlight side of Bebington Station. This is a bright lively traditional local opened up into a single bar area which has been much improved in recent years. Three hand pumps dispense regular beers including Young's Bitter and Sharp's Doom Bar but may

be replaced by guests occasionally.

Leave the pub and turn left along the side of the pub onto Brook Street. When the road forks, take the right hand road and pass the Lady Lever Art Gallery on your left. The fine collections in the gallery represent the personal taste of the first Lord Leverhulme. He began buying art in the late 1880s to use as advertising for the 'Sunlight Soap' brand that he produced. It was opened in 1922 by Princess Beatrice who was the youngest daughter of Queen Victoria.

Continue straight ahead, passing the fountain and through the gardens which run between King George's Drive and Queen Mary's Drive, passing to the right of the War Memorial and going straight ahead eventually passing Hulme Hall on your left and reaching Bolton Road. Cross the road and turn right and then left onto Bridge Street immediately after the bowling green. Follow the footpath straight on over the footbridge and turn right along Park Road towards Port Sunlight station. Cross the road with the station ahead of you and turn left heading towards the factory and turn right immediately before the Gladstone Theatre. Cross the cobbled courtyard diagonally and follow the signs onto the footpath and cycle route.

The route is along part of the Lever private railway last used as an attraction with steam hauled trains during the Port Sunlight centenary celebrations in May 1988 but now dismantled. After passing under the A41, the path finally ends and you walk up the slope, round a hair pin bend and turn left onto Stadium Road. Follow the signposted paths along the road with the retail and leisure parks on your right, turn left down Commercial

Road, right along Riverview Road and when you reach the roundabout, turn left down a footpath with the river directly ahead of you.

Continue along the footpaths with the river on your left, entering Eastham

Country Park before reaching the site of the Eastham Ferry with *The Tap* across the road. This friendly and

cosy country pub has fantastic views of the River Mersey. Known as a bikers' pub, it is popular with all. Food is available at all times in our Bear Pit Café. The beers usually include Banks's Bitter and up to two guest beers from the Marstons range.

Turn right out of the pub and walk up the road. On your right is the site of the Victorian Pleasure Gardens

which included a zoo with lions. bears and monkeys and on your left the entrance to the Manchester Ship Canal. On reaching Eastham village, on your right is the *Hooton* Arms, a friendly street corner local with up to three changing guest beers.



On leaving the pub, turn left and follow the road to the right passing the church on your left. After a couple

of hundred yards you will find the **Montgomery Pub** & **Kitchen**. Formerly the Stanley Arms, the pub reopened in 2013 as a gastro pub with a rotating range of three cask beers, usually including one from a local brewery.



Leaving the pub turn right and head to the

A41. Cross the main road, turn right and after the shops turn left up Bridle Road. After ¾ mile on the left is the entrance to the *Knockaloe Bar & Restaurant*.

Formerly the Octel Social Club, the 'OC' is now a family friendly pub open to all with up to six beers on hand pump including Brimstage Trappers Hat. There is a large patio area outside and food is available throughout the day.



For the journey home,

turn left out of the OC and at the traffic lights, go straight on or turn right and onto the A41 for busses or turn left and walk ½ mile to Bromborough railway station.



Gardening To Do List - October in the Garden

Gardening in October is entirely dependent on the weather. If there's an Indian Summer, there is no better time of year to be out in the garden. While

gardeners in warm areas will have more to do than their northern counterparts, there are plenty of garden tasks to keep everyone busy in October.

Tidy Borders

Keep on weeding and have a gentle tidy up in your borders but do try to resist the temptation of a thorough spring clean. Leave seedheads for the birds if you don't want to collect them and as much cover as you can bear for wildlife who will appreciate the winter shelter.

Fallen leaves can be left to rot down (or collected for leaf mould), however diseased material is another matter, make it a priority to clear and burn it to prevent pests and diseases overwintering courtesy of your kind hospitality! Put the rest of your garden rubbish (apart from woody stems) in the compost.



Start your compost

If you haven't already done so, start your compost going by buying a bin or building a partially enclosed area for a heap. It is vital to replace the goodness in soil after a hefty growing season and autumn produces masses of garden waste that will put invaluable organic richness back into the ground for next spring.

Add a variety of different materials; spent vegetable and bedding plants, herbaceous leftovers, thatch, moss and cuttings from the lawn, weeds (but not the roots unless they have been through a shredder), hedge clippings, kitchen peelings and tea bags are ideal.

Prepare your soil for next year

Your soil is your most precious commodity, so start digging in compost, manure and as much organic matter as you can lay your hands on to replace the goodness in it. Healthy soil is the basis of healthy plants and a healthy environment. When garden soil is in good shape there is less need for fertilizers or pesticides.

The earlier you start the better, especially if your soil is heavy. It can be left in a pretty rough state over the winter when the elements will break the clods down, making spring planting infinitely easier! Proper pH is also an essential characteristic of healthy soil.



Rake fallen leaves

Don't waste fallen leaves (except those perilous rose leaves and evergreens, which take too long to rot down) - given time they decompose into fabulously rich leaf mould - aka 'nature's soil conditioner of choice'! Rake up fallen leaves and chuck them into a simple frame to make leaf mould (black bin liners spiked with air holes will also do if you can bear the visual offense - but remember to dampen the leaves first). If left to linger on the lawn for long, the grass will turn yellow. Leaf mould takes about a year to mature, a great top dressing for woodland plants such as rhododendrons and is an excellent and **FREE** home-grown substitute for peat.








GET FOILED

Learn why foil-packet cooking is hot, hot, hot

s the saying goes, big things come in small packages and that may explain the burgeoning popularity of foil-packet recipes.

Minimal preparation and cleanup are easy trade-offs for the immense flavours you can create in these tiny containers, whether you prepare them in the oven, on the grill or over an open flame.

Servings: 4

Prep time: 10 minutes Cook time: 45 minutes

- tablespoons Seasoned Rice Vinegar
 - Roasted Garlic
- 2 teaspoons gochujang (chile bean paste)
- tablespoons maple syrup
- 4 teaspoons soy sauce
- tablespoons, plus 2 teaspoons, olive oil
- 4 teaspoons Dijon mustard
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 8 chicken thighs
- cups fresh cauliflower, riced (use grater or food processer so cauliflower resembles rice)
- 1 1/2 cups fresh scallions, sliced
- 2 cups fresh sugar snap peas
- 3 sprigs fresh cilantro, for garnish

Heat oven or grill to 375 F.

In large bowl, mix together vinegar, gochujang, maple syrup, soy sauce, olive oil, mustard, salt and pepper to form marinade. Dip chicken in marinade and toss lightly until coated

Lightly oil foil pouch and layer base of pouch with cauliflower. Add scallions and sugar snap peas then place chicken on top. Carefully pour remaining marinade over pouch contents (ensuring that liquid stays inside foil).

Seal foil packet and bake or grill 30 minutes. Open foil to create 2-inch long vent then bake or grill another 15 minutes, or until completely cooked. Garnish with cilantro before serving.

Chef's tip: For best results and added flavour, marinate chicken 30 minutes before preparing pouches.

Substitutions: In place of gochujang, red pepper flake paste can be made by mixing 1 tablespoon red pepper flakes with a few dashes soy sauce and 1 dash sugar. Alternatively, substitute 2 teaspoons sriracha for gochujang.


