

Tenants will be given more rights when changes to the Landlord and Tenant Act 1985 are made on 20 March 2019. People who rent will be able to sue their landlords if their homes are not up to scratch. Issues with damp, noise, ventilation, repairs, drainage, infestations and facilities for cooking are a number of the issue's tenants will be able to take action on. It will cover tenants immediately and not just for new tenancies, existing tenancies will be covered. These changes mean that those in social housing will now have more power to force local authorities to carry out necessary repairs.

It is estimated that over 1 million rented homes have hazards that pose a serious risk. The new changes will mean that tenants will be able to take their landlord to court for an injunction to compel the landlord to carry out the works or for damages (compensation) for the landlord's failure to keep the property in good repair.

Compensation can also be paid to tenants for any issues that have caused injury or illness.







Light up a Life for Wirral Hospice St John's





Light up a Life has been raising much needed funds for Wirral Hospice St John's ever since the first service in 1996. It's a really special time of year which brings together our Wirral community to remember their loved ones. This year the hospice gardens will be lit with 10,000 beautiful lights on Sunday 8th December.

The lights will be switched on by Tracie Powell in memory of her husband Allan, Tracie will switch the lights on with her daughter, Kerry, and grandchildren, Morgan, 17, and Jeyda, 10. Allan had been feeling ill for a while before he was taken to hospital in February 2017 after collapsing with what turned out to be a perforated bowel. A little time later the family were given the shattering news that Allan had bowel cancer and it had progressed to stage 4. He was determined to be around for as long as possible and underwent chemotherapy over several months to make the most of his time with the family.

They all describe Allan as a fighter and, often when seriously ill, he would rally and be back to feeling as well as could be, enjoying quality time watching movies with Morgan and 'colouring-in' with Jeyda.

Allan's first referral to Wirral Hospice St John's was in April 2018 and he was admitted for three weeks. Once he was made more comfortable he was able to return home to be with Tracie and the family. He also attended the Hospice Wellbeing Centre for a few sessions and this gave give Tracie a much needed break. He was able to spend time with other patients and joined in some activities. Allan was an avid reader and was able to spend quiet moments reading whilst at the Hospice.

In July 2018 Allan was admitted onto our Inpatient Unit again. He received the specialist care and support which would give Tracie, Kerry and the grandchildren some peace of mind and precious

time together. They enjoyed picnics in the sunshine in the Hospice garden and talked about family holidays. Their Yorkshire terrier, Alfie, visited the Hospice too and enjoyed a cuddle from Allan. Sadly, Allan died on 29th July, 2018 and is dearly missed by his loving family.

Tracie has received bereavement support from the Hospice and has made new friends through the bereavement group. She has also joined the hospice as a volunteer.

On being approached to switch on the lights Tracie was delighted to accept, she said; "The hospice was magnificent with and for Allan. The help I have personally received since has been wonderful. We all feel honoured to be able to switch on the lights, as we know it means so much for many families living in, and with family ties to, Wirral. Allan, the family and I had supported Light up a Life previously, remembering other loved ones and now we can play a part, in memory of Allan, to help people with their own special memories"

The service will be held in the hospice gardens on **Sunday 8th December at 5.30pm**. The carol service is free to attend and all are welcome to come along to remember their loved ones. For

each light that is sponsored a loved one's name is included in the hospice books of honour and people receive a Light up a Life card in their memory. The books are on display in the hospice from **4pm on 8th December** and will remain on display throughout the Christmas period.

For a suggested minimum donation of £5 per light you can sponsor a Light in memory of a loved one. Light up a Life keepsake tree decorations are also available for a donation from £5.00 (including postage). All businesses are included in the event programme and in the books of honour.

Each light represents someone special who is loved and remembered whether people have a connection to the hospice or not. ADDITIONAL MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORT FOR SCHOOLS ACROSS WIRRAL

Young people in Wirral will soon receive enhanced mental health and wellbeing support in schools and colleges following the announcement of new NHS funding.

As part of NHS England's national investment into young people's mental health services, a partnership between local mental health provider CWP and Wirral Health and Care Commissioning (including Education) has been successful in a bid for additional funding to develop new Mental Health Support Teams (MHSTs) across Wirral.

The programme includes just under a £1million funding invested into local mental health provision and aims for Wirral MHSTs to be established by September 2020 in pilot schools.

MHSTs will deliver immediate advice and early intervention on mild to moderate mental health and emotional wellbeing issues, such as anxiety, behavioural difficulties or friendship issues, as well as providing help to staff within a school and college setting. The teams will act as a link with local children and young people's mental health services and be supervised by NHS staff.

Sheena Cumiskey, CWP Chief Executive, said: "I'm delighted that, together with our local partners, we've been able to secure additional funding to

support the mental health and wellbeing of young people in our communities.

"We know that 50% of mental health problems are established by age 14, and a key part of the NHS Long Term Plan is embedding mental health support in schools and colleges. It's wonderful to see health and education experts coming together to ensure our young people can receive the right support in the right place at the right time."

Simon Banks, Chief Officer, Wirral Health and Care Commissioning said: "A key part of Wirral's approach to supporting the emotional health and wellbeing of children and young people is to build resilience and address mental health concerns before they become severe. The investment in Mental Health Support Teams in schools will enable more children to receive support and will help prevent mental health problems developing.

"This collaboration between schools, local authority and the NHS is a great example of Wirral's focus on joint-working between agencies and reflects the wider partnership approach of Wirral Health & Care Commissioning."

OREVIEW by Tony Yates

Keeping you motoring

Peugeot 508 SW GT PureTech 225 EAT8 S&S 8-Speed Automatic



This month's road test puts me in the driving seat of the new Peugeot 508 SW. First off, the 508 SW is a great looking car with some wonderful swooping lines flanking its sides. I mean, just look at it - its stunning in size and proportion. The SW version I currently have on test, for me, has to be the best-looking estate car currently on the market right now.

Plus, not only is the 508 SW full of tech - it's also full of special little details that make you go all tingly on the inside. And when I say tingly, I mean tingly. Only recently, I parked it outside my local supermarket, and everyone was looking - even the BMW drivers turned their heads to look, and rightly so, because Peugeot has grown massively recently and if you are like me, then you are beginning to see more and more interesting designs coming forward - plus more innovation. I just hope this is the tip of the iceberg from Peugeot. I'm very excited to see what more there is to come with future models. But for now, let's get on with this week's review.

Power and Efficiency:

The 508 SW I had on test was powered by a 1598cc, 4-cylinder turbocharged petrol engine that has 225HP on tap, which also happens to boast a top speed of 153mph, plus a 0-62 time of 7.4 seconds. Fuel consumption is also very good with a combined figure of around 39mpg. There is also 300Nm of torque to keep you very happy when you really do need to take swift overtaking action. A big plus point for this car though is the brilliant EAT8 (Efficient Automatic Transmission) 8-speed gearbox that does a proper job of changing up and down the gears at a decent rate with minimal fuss. Also, for a 1.6Litre engine – it's very refined – and its low grunt and steady power delivery makes for a good unit truth be told.

On the road:

First off – great chassis, along with a suspension setup that's really good, even when going over some serious potholes. The steering is also direct, and the grip levels are astonishingly good, which

means the 508 SW feels tight and taught into the corners. I'm going to say that Peugeot has done an excellent job of getting the whole package to work together and I have no issues in saying that it performs very well out on the open road. Well done Peugeot!

On the motorway – the 508 SW really does feel like a Grand Tourer estate – which is not surprising. Also, I did over 450 miles and I still felt relaxed and composed even after a long drive. Also, this being the 'SW' version also means the boot is huge and well equipped to take the family away on a long haul trip across France, or just a short hop with the weekly shopping. One thing that is for sure though is that you will never be out of space because the 508 SW has buckets of it. (Seats up: 590 Litres Folded: 1780 Litres)

Interior & Technology:

The interior is also equipped to a good standard – with lots of chrome fittings and clear displays and soft-touch surfaces. Along with a decent amount of standard equipment such as; Power Folding door mirrors, Split folding rear seats (1/3 2/3), Electric power steering, 3 x retractable rear head restraints, driver and front passenger massage function ** Automatic dual-zone air conditioning, Electric

parking brake, Smart electric tailgate ** 180° reversing camera and sensors, RDS radio/MP3 player, Full LED headlights with cornering function, MirrorScreen with Apple CarPlay, LED Daytime Running Lights, FOCAL® premium HiFi speakers **

Plus, LED front indicators, USB socket x 2 - Smartphone charging plate, Rear LED PEUGEOT 'Claw Effect' lights, Bluetooth® handsfree and media streaming system, Automatic lights, Connected 3D Navigation, Automatic windscreen wipers, 'Follow me home headlamps', 19in Diamond-cut 'Augusta' alloy wheels ** Nera Black door mirror shells, Night Vision & Body-colour door handles. ** Exclusive to GT specification

To sum up:

I'm going to give the 508 SW five stars in this test, not only because I like its looks, but because I believe it's a good family mile muncher with bags of extras and space – plus a decent engine that's tied to a really good chassis & transmission.

Can you believe it's already November? This year has flown by and in the flash of an eye we're deep into the autumn. Many may think that as November comes, there isn't many jobs to do in the garden. This is untrue! There's plenty of tidying, protection for winter and preparations for next year to do! Here's what we think you should do this month:



Clear up fallen leaves — don't leave them on grass for too long or they will kill the lawn beneath. Leave them on beds however as earthworms will pull them into their burrows, continuing the natural cycle. The nutrients from these leaves will replenish your soil.

If the fallen leaves are covering small plants, remove them so they do not suffocate the plants beneath. Sweep off paths and terraces to keep the garden looking cared for. With all of these leaves you have collected, create a separate pile next to your compost heap. As they begin to mould, it will rot into a great soil improver as the remnants of the leaf retain moisture and helps with drainage.

Plant tulip bulbs in time for spring — Now is the perfect time to get planting! Your bulbs will keep nice and cozy in the ground over winter, ready to sprout as spring comes!

Insulate outdoor containers! Any plant pots or containers that will be staying outside this winter must be protected! If your plants get too cold, they will die. We suggest wrapping them in bubble wrap as an extra layer of protection from the frosts. It would also be a good step to raise your pots using blocks



or bricks to prevent them from being waterlogged when the rain comes.

Feed the birds!!! During winter, birds need all the help they can get. Frosty ground and a lack of new growth can make it very difficult for them to find food. Help them out by investing in a bird table and leaving food out for them. Suet is a great snack to leave out for your feathered friends as it is very high in calories so will boost their energy. You could also try fruit, millet and seed mixes as these will give the birds a variety of nutrients. Seed mixes are also perfect as the different seeds will attract different types of bird, giving you even more species to spot!

Another thing you may not expect to be giving birds is salt! Salt is an essential mineral in a bird's diet, however they often try to get it off of the road when they have been gritted which is extremely dangerous. If you create a saltwater solution and let it evaporate to crystals, you can place it on a bird table or place them on a log.

Use your bonfire to dispose of garden debris that is unfit for composting. This could be leaves that have fallen from rose bushes that have suffered with blackspot or rust or debris from an



apple tree with apple scab. This will reduce the risk of infection next year.

Plant out winter plants such as heathers, grasses and ivy to provide your garden with a splash of colour this winter.

It's time to harvest your parsnips!
Once the first frosts have hit, it's the perfect time to dig up your parsnips as they will have just begun to sweeten in flavour.

You may feel like this is the end of the fruit and vegetable growing season but you would be wrong! This is a great time to plant up a perennial vegetable bed of rhubarb and asparagus crowns as well as autumn garlic and mushrooms.

You can also plant raspberry canes and currant bushes! As for the plants you have already harvested, spread the beds with manure to rot down over winter, prune your apple and pear trees and tidy up your strawberry plants.

November also brings Bonfire Night, but how can you keep yourself and your garden safe this month?



Sorghum Pancakes

Recipe provided by Barbara Kliment

1 3/4 cups sorghum flour

1/4 cup cornstarch

3 teaspoons baking powder

2 teaspoons sugar

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/2 cup powdered buttermilk

2 eggs

3 tablespoons melted butter

1 1/2 cups water

eat oven to 200°F. Combine dry ingredients. In separate bowl, beat together eggs, melted butter and water; add to dry ingredients and mix just until well blended. Heat large skillet or griddle over medium-low heat. Spray pan with cooking oil. Wet fingertips under faucet and shake them over hot griddle.

If water droplets "sizzle," heat is right to begin making pancakes.

For large cakes pour 1/4 cup of batter into pan; for small use 2 tablespoons of batter. Cook until bubbles form on top; flip and cook until golden brown on bottom. Transfer to baking sheet and keep warm in oven while making rest of pancakes. Serve warm with butter and syrup.

Chewy Oatmeal Toffee Cookies

Recipe provided by Kate Lange

1 cup butter, softened

2 eggs

2 cups light brown sugar 2 teaspoons vanilla extract

1 cup sorghum flour

3/4 cup unbleached white flour

1/2 teaspoon salt

1 teaspoon baking soda

1/8 teaspoon allspice

1 1/2 teaspoons cinnamon

1/8 teaspoon cloves

3 cups oatmeal

1 cup coconut flakes

1(10-ounce) package of almond toffee bits



eat oven to 375°F. Lightly grease cookie sheet. Cream butter, eggs, brown sugar and vanilla in large bowl until light and fluffy. Mix flour, salt, soda, allspice, cinnamon and cloves; add to butter mixture. Beat until well blended. Stir in oatmeal, coconut and toffee bits with spoon. Drop by rounded teaspoons about 2 inches apart onto prepared sheet. Bake 8-10 minutes or until edges are lightly browned. Cool 1 minute; remove to wire rack.






