

Have you paid a deposit to your landlord for the tenancy?

Did your landlord protect that deposit in one of the Tenancy Deposit Schemes?

If the landlord has failed to protect the deposit or has protected it yet not provided you with the relevant information then you can make a claim against your landlord to have the deposit returned. Additionally, you can ask the court for damages to the value of up to three times the value of the deposit paid.

If your landlord has failed to protect your deposit then they are not able to obtain possession of the property using S21 Housing Act.



## Ito Review by Tony Yates

Keeping you motoring

New Ford Ranger 'Raptor' - Jurassic Park on 4 wheels



For this weeks review. I feel like I'm on the set of the new Jurassic World movie. The Ford Ranger 'Raptor' you see before you here is not only menacing, it's downright wonderful. For years I have always had a soft spot for the Land Rover Defender - and I still do. but the 'Raptor' goes one step more in the looks department. Also, having a vehicle with the words 'Raptor wrote down the side is pretty cool. Just as cool as the jacked-up suspension and the blacked-out windows. Plus wherever you park the 'Raptor', it turns heads. To be honest, I wish all vehicles of this type had funky names such as; the 'Indominus rex' or if we're getting really crazy here, how about some real classic Jurassic Park predators such as the 'Tyrannosaurus' or the 'Velociraptor'.

#### **Power and Efficiency:**

The 'Raptor' version I had on test was fitted with a 2.0-litre EcoBlue - 213 PS diesel engine and a 10-speed automatic gearbox. Torque, well let's just say it has more than enough grunt to keep you going (500Nm in fact). For those of you who want to know the combined fuel consumption? Well, let's just say it was good (around 31.7mpg) Plus the brilliant thing about owning a Ford Ranger 'Raptor' is that it will basically tow a ship or anything else that takes your fancy. Top speed, well let's just say it will max out at around106mph.

#### On the road:

Well, it's basically a pickup truck on steroids. So it acts just like a pickup truck, and you would think it's slow – but it's not actually - and of course it feels fast because you are up so high – which

means everybody else looks small. The suspension setup is lovely and it doesn't feel like a pickup at all. Actually its really refined, but still able to do all the off-road stuff you would expect a vehicle like this to do. Talking about off-road, I took the 'Raptor' on quick 'field trip' around the muddy roads and rivers where I live - and to my surprise it was brilliant. We have also had a lot of rain here recently, but that did not stop the 'Raptor' making its way through enough mud that would make even a Land Rover Defender think twice.

#### **Interior & Technology:**

The inside was kitted out very well, and here are some of the features you can expect to get as standard on the Ford Ranger 'Raptor including; Unique 17" alloy wheels with all-terrain tyres, Unique Raptor front grille, Widened front and rear wheel arches with 150 mm wider track, Aerodynamic sports hoop with integrated load box illumination, Unique front and rear bumpers, Front aluminium skid plate, FOX Pro shock absorbers with position-sensitive damping, Front and rear ventilated disc brakes, Four off-road tow hooks, Strengthened alloy side steps, Loadbox

roller shutter and carry bars. Plus; Unique Raptor suede trim with heated and power-adjustable seats, Unique perforated leather sports steering wheel with centre marker and Raptor logo, Unique instrument panel cluster, Terrain Management System with six selectable drive modes, FordPass Connect onboard modem, SYNC 3 with 8" Touchscreen and Navigation.

I can also tell you that the inside does not feel cheaply made either and you get plenty of toys to play with and all the controls are set out nicely with many of the buttons and switches having a quality feel. Even the seating is brilliant and nothing like you would expect from a car with the words 'workhorse' in mind.

#### To sum up:

I really was impressed by the new Ford Raptor, yes it may look like a Pop Star's 4X4 -but I'm telling you now - the new Raptor is the real deal - it's a real 'workhorse' Buy it now!












#### The Impact of dot-art Schools – New Research Unveiled!



dot-art Schools believes the arts have the power to change and shape young people's lives.

For many Liverpool City Region schools, the annual dot-art Schools inter-school art competition is already a well-established

fixture in the academic calendar as it launches its eighth year. The online art competition culminates in a public exhibition of the winning artworks and a prize giving celebration for teachers, students and their families. The competition is open to all Primary (Year 5) and Secondary (Year 9) and SEND schools in the six boroughs of Liverpool City Region and the surrounding area. It is designed to nurture talent, raise ambition and take art out of the classroom into the real world.

The competition was established in 2012 in response to demand from local schools and the side-lining of the arts in the curriculum, to date over 6700 children from 398 schools have taken part Participating in the competition can contribute to a school's Artsmark journey, boost students' self-esteem, raise their aspirations and engage student's families.

Earlier this year, dot-art Schools were delighted to be accepted for the CERI (Cultural Education Research Initiative) research project. CERI is a partnership between Curious Minds and Liverpool Hope University to support research-informed practice in cultural education.

The research offered an opportunity to examine what impact participating in the competition has had on both the school and students, and to map and learn more about the social,

economic and educational context those schools sit within. We wanted to discover what motivates schools to take part in dot-art Schools competition. investigate the reasons for the diverse quality of artwork entered and address ways to support teachers to improve the quality of pupil's art experiences. Does competing build quality, so schools produce better art as a result?

"I think the fact that they get to have their work displayed at Liverpool school of art and design, that was just amazing and to have the parents come along, to really show the children that this is a kind of a career, this is something you could do in life. It's not something a lot of them had even considered and then they were just in awe."

"It's a nice way to celebrate our pupils work and for them to receive acknowledgement for the work they've done. I think the awards ceremony is fantastic for boosting their selfesteem getting them out of their comfort zone"

SEN teacher interviewee CERI Researcher Adam Haunch states:

"The dot art Schools programme has reached out to particularly deprived communities, in a manner that is not only inclusive but that has brought out the very best that these communities have to offer, resulting in, at primary level, schools in highly deprived areas being far more successful than their affluent peers. This is undoubtedly evidence that the cultural capital of these participants has been significantly increased."

The dot-art Schools programme aims to encourage and nurture talent by celebrating and showcasing Year 5 & Year 9 students' artworks both online and in public exhibitions. This research enabled us to gather measurable data on the impact we're having and analyse that data to develop future strategies to improve our offer. The research has clarified

how our work impacts on schools and young people and will inform our planning for new ways we can best support teachers.

We looked at data about participating schools from 2012 – 2018 to give a demographic context of the schools that have taken part. We discovered that 64% of the participating primary schools and 50% of the secondary schools are in the most deprived quarter of the UK population.

The researcher from Liverpool Hope University also conducted interviews with teachers from a representative range of schools and those competing regularly as well as for the first time. dot-art Schools project manager Carolyn Murray commented:

## Walking Over Hot Coals For Wirral Hospice St John's



Wirral Hospice St John's holds a special place in the hearts and minds of Wirral people. Many have raised thousands of pounds completing challenges to help the hospice to raise monies to continue to provide its expert pain management and symptom control for people with life-limiting illnesses as well as support for their families.

In 2019, events such as a Walk in the Park, It's a Knockout and Mucky Mudder have attracted hundreds of supporters to 'have a go' in hospice managed events, while others have signed up for personal trials of endurance, organised by others, to walk, run, swim, skydive and cycle to raise funds for the hospice.

And now, we know that people are prepared, literally, to walk over hot coals to show their, and their sponsors, magnificent commitment to the hospice.

Recently, more than 50 hardy souls, ('soles'?) displayed a rousing level of dedication to walk, barefoot, over several feet of glowing hot embers in Wirral Hospice St John's first ever FireWalk, which was staged next to the hospice grounds.

A team of around ten hospice staff and regular volunteers joined the rest of the prospective firewalkers in a motivational workshop an hour before the event, delivered by master firewalk instructor, Steve Consalvez of Success Formulae.

Some people were 'in the zone' early during the sessiom and demonstrated supreme focus by agreeing to walk over broken glass or breaking arrows, normally used in archery, against a wall using only their throats! All this before embarking on the FireWalk.

Outside was a stunning sight for a large and supportive, and possibly more apprehensive, crowd of spectators who watched as organisers set fire to a bonfire of charcoal logs for the firewalk, with the atmosphere being further stoked by Batala Mersey, an exciting drumming band who brought the upbeat rhythm of Afro-Brazilian samba to an exciting and inspirational evening.

The audience cheered and chanted loudly as each of the Firewalkers emerged from the workshop and lined up to take their first step. Then, after a deep breath, each person strode across the glowing mass of embers, sparks and cinders burning at around 1000 degrees Fahrenheit.

Now, a special type of respect is ascribed to all those people who crashed through their personal barriers to walking purposefully over several metres of hot coals and all to raise funds for their beloved, local hospice.

"It was a special evening. We're so in awe of our fabulous firewalkers and, in fact, of all of the individuals and businesses who take part in, and support the hospice through sponsorship, challenges and events throughout the year. These machines were required by the local by-laws to be used when bathing.



Total time: **5 hours, 45 minutes** (inc. refrigerating)

Makes: 16 servings

1 1/2 cups digestive biscuit crumbs

3 tablespoons sugar

- 1/3 cup butter or margarine, melted 4 packages (8 ounces each) PHILADELPHIA
  - Cream Cheese, softened 1 cup sugar
  - 1 teaspoon vanilla
  - 4 eggs
  - 1 cup canned cherries

HEAT oven to 325°F.

**MIX** digestive crumbs, 3 tablespoons sugar and butter; press onto bottom of 9-inch springform pan.

**BEAT** cream cheese, 1 cup sugar and vanilla with mixer until blended. Add eggs, 1 at a time, mixing on low speed after each just until blended. Pour over crust.

**BAKE** 1 hour or until centre is almost set. Run knife around rim of pan to loosen cake; cool before removing rim. Refrigerate cheesecake 4 hours. Top with canned cherries, if desired.



## CAMRA WIRRAL PUB TRAIL

HOOTON — LITTLE NESTON - PARKGATE, 5/6 PUBS. 7½ MILES MAINLY ON COUNTRY FOOTPATHS.



Start at Hooton Station and the adjacent **Hooton Hotel**. Turn left along the main road and just after the top of the bridge over the railway, turn left down the marked footpath along the Wirral Way. This follows the tracks of the old Hooton to West Kirby railway line which was closed in 1962.

In less than a mile you pass under a road bridge and after a few hundred more yards, where a fence forms a barrier partially blocking the track, turn off to the right and follow a narrow path which runs parallel to the Wirral Way. After a few hundred yards this opens up to a wide track, Smithy Lane, which you follow into Willaston. When you reach Hadlow Road turn right and go to the end of the road where opposite you will see, the **Nags Head**. Extensively Refurbhished in 2011, this pub combines good food and good beer in warm relaxing surroundings. Four beers include York Guzzler and Otter Bitter. See our advert **P.56** 



Return along Hadlow Road but continue until reach Hadlow Road Station. preserved followina closure passengers in 1956. Turn riaht along the Wirral Wav and continue

under three road bridges, following the marked footpath. Less than half a mile after the last bridge (the A540 Chester High Road) you cross a footbridge over a track and immediately turn left down steps and over a stile at the bottom. Turn right and follow the track straight ahead which narrows to a footpath. After less than half a mile turn right following the main pathway. You will eventually emerge on Gorstons Lane where you turn left, keeping the houses on your right. At the end of the road turn right following the road and keeping the school on your left hand side. Follow Woodfall Lane downhill, at the main road turn right then follow the road (Bull Hill) to the left continuing downhill until you reach a roundabout. Cross the roundabout and continue down Bull Hill then Marshlands Lane until you reach the Dee Marshes.

Turn left and after two hundred yards you arrive at the **Harp Inn**. The pub is a former coal miners' inn near to the site of Neston Colliery which closed in 1927. Converted from two cottages, it has a public bar with real fire in winter and a drinking area at the front overlooking the marshes. The beer range includes Landlord, Holt Bitter, Peerless Triple Blonde plus two guest beers.

Turn right out of the pub and go straight on passing the bottom

of Marshlands Lane and follow the track ahead keeping the Marshes on your left. The track becomes a footpath, then over a stile and into open ground crossing three wooden foot bridges before becoming a footpath on the edge of the marshes. Follow the footpath which can be



boggy or overgrown at times until you reach a track where you have to turn right away from the marshes. When you reach the road turn left onto Manorial Road South and continue straight ahead eventually onto Manorial Road. At the end of the road take the footpath on the left and this brings you back to the marshes and onto the Parade at Parkgate.

300 yards on the right is the **Ship Hotel**. The hotel dates from 1787 when it was known as the Princess Royal after a

locally-built ship. The hotel bar serves food all day and features historic photos of old Parkgate. Beers include Brimstage Trappers Hat plus three quests.

Another 200 yards along the Parade is the Red Lion. This is an excellent multiroomed traditional



inn and the oldest unchanged pub in Parkgate, dating from 1822. One central bar serves the public bar and cosy lounge with Courage Bitter, Tetley Bitter and Hobgoblin plus occasional guest ales and good value food at lunch time.

Turn right out of the **Red Lion**, 100 yards to the square to catch a bus home. Routes X22 and 22 (not Sunday) Heswall to Chester, 487 (evenings and Sunday) to Liverpool via Bebington and Birkenhead. Or if you have time before the bus arrives, continue along the Parade to the Boat House where the bar serves up to six changing beers, including its own house beers from Conwy Brewerv.
