

A demand for fitness, sports coaching and high-quality PE lessons for children has led to the expansion of a local sports and coaching business. The move will ensure all schools across Merseyside & Cheshire can benefit from dedicated classes, as obesity levels for the region remain high.

More than 22000 children leave primary school severely obese. 28% of 2-15 years were classed as overweight or obese. At the start of primary school one in 10 children are obese and by the end, that has increased to one in five. Those growing up in the most deprived communities are at the greatest risk. The chances of being obese are about twice that of those who live in the least deprived areas.

Founder & Director Nicky Adams says eg "We are seeing first-hand the commitment from our schools in supporting pupils to increase their levels of physical activity and we work them to ensure all children have access to a variety of opportunities to suit the least active to the most sporty. We also offer some amazing mental health and self-development programmes and have achieved some fantastic results.

We are also members of the Children's Activities Association so schools and parents know that we have been vetted in providing high quality services.

As part of the expansion, all Merseyside schools are eligible for a **FREE PE Health Check**.

Lesley Roach, Headteacher, Sacred Heart Catholic Primary school in Liverpool said "As a healthy school we promote the health and well-being of all our pupils in school and for the past year we have worked alongside Jordan and the Full of Beans team. 








REVIEW by Tony Yates

Keeping you motoring

New Peugeot 208 GT Line 1.2 PureTech 100 S&S 6-speed manual



This is my first review of 2020 - so let me start with saying I wish you all a very Happy New Year.

Right, now that's out the way, let's get on with this week's review of the new-look Peugeot 208 GT Line. But, before I do, I just wanted to say that over the Christmas & New Year period, I spoke to a lot of people at various shows and celebrations and one of the topics that constantly came up was EVs. Many people have told me that this year they are ditching their petrol engine vehicles and are instead going out to buy their first EV. Now, call me a critic - but we are not there yet, we're close, but it's not all plain sailing quite yet because we need a decent charging infrastructure first, followed by another dozen things.

So, to align with this - I plan on testing a lot more EVs throughout 2020 which I hope will help you decide if you want to join the 'green revolution' or like me, you think we're just not quite there yet and you would rather wait a little bit longer before you commit to throwing the combustion engine onto the scrapheap

forever. On a personal note; I will always be a petrol head - and when the time comes that the only other option for me is to use a vehicle that's powered solely by battery power - then maybe I just won't bother at all.

Power and Efficiency:

The 1.2-litre PureTech petrol engine has a 0-62 time of around 9.9 seconds and a top speed of 117mph. Fuel consumption is also good, giving a combined figure of 53mpg. So, the next question is; how well does it get a move on? Well, if I'm being honest it moves along quite nicely. That 1.2 petrol engine for me is smooth and silky. The 6-speed gearbox is also slick, and the gear changes are direct and firm. There used to be a time when floppy Peugeot gearchanges were the norm, but not anymore thankfully.

On the road:

The 100PS engine that was fitted to my test car was enthusiastic and pretty much purred its way along. Also, into the corners, the chassis felt

poised and tight, even when dealing with our worst roads. Plus, when the tarmac gets twisty, the little 208 is fun to drive, it's a little corker, giving you maximum grip in and out of every corner. The steering also felt direct and perfectly balanced - with plenty of feedback on what all four corners are doing at any given time.

Interior & Technology:

First off - I'm so glad to see that the designers at Peugeot have finally paid a lot of attention to the detail inside the cabin of the new 208 - thankfully its now refreshing and modern. Also, the seats are comfy once you get the correct adjustment which I found a little annoying to get just right. When it comes to the boot - the space is OK, with more room than I expected there to be if I'm being honest. Trust me on this, you will be very surprised just how much you can fit in. Rear legroom was also not bad.

On the inside:

There's plenty of standard equipment, which includes; managing to fit in a family with minimal effort. Plus; 17" 'Camden' diamond-cut two-tone alloy wheels, gloss black wheel arch extensions, GT Line badging, active safety brake, ABS with EBD, Thatcham Category 1 approved alarm, ESP with Hill Start Assist, Peugeot i-Cockpit 7" colour touchscreen, DAB radio & 6-speakers, automatic headlights and tyre pressure sensors. To find out more, might I suggest you visit www.peugeot.co.uk.

To sum up:

I like the new 208 because of its practicability aspect, plus it's a hoot to drive. It also has bags of power for a small car, along with plenty of space on the inside.

Wirral Hospice St John's has held a special place in the hearts of our whole Wirral community for over 36 years now.

People who have, through family and friends, experienced its specialist medical and nursing care and those who support through volunteering, raising funds and making kind donations are all massive advocates for the hospice.

Why Make A Will?

It's natural for people to believe there's plenty of time before they have to take this important step, but experience tells us that it's never too early. If your Will is not officially drawn up then your assets may be subject to processes under the law which may have negative repercussions for loved ones for many years.

You may already have a Will in place but major changes can happen in life, including marriage, divorce, having children or

even the death of a loved one, which can potentially invalidate some, or all, of a current Will.

Unmarried partners or those who have not registered a civil partnership cannot inherit from each other unless there is a Will in place. Homeowners and people with dependent children are especially encouraged to have an up-to-date Will.

A list of the legal organisations offering the service this April, in partnership with the hospice, appears here.

Legacies

Legacies have become a significant part of hospice income and, although amounts greatly vary according to people's circumstances, Wirral Hospice St John's is extremely grateful when people choose to leave a gift of any size.

Anything that is left to charity is not counted towards the total taxable value of your estate and if you leave at least 10% of your 'net estate' to a charity it can cut inheritance tax from 40% to 36% where that may be applicable.

Please do note that if you further choose to leave something to the hospice, or any other charity, in your will it is totally for your discretion and completely confidential between you and your solicitor, there is absolutely no obligation to leave a gift in your Will to the hospice.

There are different ways of leaving a gift in your Will;

Residual legacy: A gift of the remainder or share of your estate, after all other gifts are given and debts cleared

Pecuniary legacy: A gift of a fixed sum of money

Specific legacy: A gift of a particular named item such as jewellery, a painting, a car or such like.

In April 2019, around 140 people drew up their Wills which, in itself, raised over £16,000 in massively important donations to Wirral Hospice St John's.

Left: 1834. Eastham windmill was originally sited in Carlett Park but in 1834 it was taken down and moved to the Chester side of Eastham Village. One of the sails was blown off during a gale in the last century so the miller removed the opposite sail. This worked well until a storm in 1895 blew the remaining two sails down, and the miller used them to repair his other mill at Willaston. This photograph shows how the mill lokked without any sails at the turn of the century. This mill was demolished in the 1930s. In 1932 a transport cafe was built on the site adjoining the mill by Cartwright Bros. This was later to become The Little Chef in the 1970s. Todav it is better known as Starbucks on A41





Above and far right: C1905. Looking down Ferry Road, Eastham with Lock Road on the right where the shed advertises a "covered bicycle stand". The pony and trap probably belonged to the photographer, F. Walker of Little Sutton, whose wife was sitting in the trap. The tea rooms, pictured above in Ferry Road, are here called Greenwoods, ready for any visitors to the Ferry from Liverpool and Seacombe.

Right: The sign above the door reads 'RV 1733' and probably refers to Richard Vernon. In 1822 records show that it was named 'The White Horse' but by 1850 it had changed to 'The Nag's Head' in Willaston. In the 1930s the building was structurally altered. See below photograph. Wm. Delamere was the victualler as well as the shopkeeper. George Barnes was the licensee in this 1910 photograph.





Left: Taken in the early 1930s. The Nag's Head has undergone major alterations from the inn pictured above. The house plate was repositioned to the centre, all the front windows have been altered and the brickwork pebbledashed. The building to the right which was once owned by the bailiff had been demolished, the road widened and Cannell Court Flats built on the site.

Right: Looking along Chester Road, **Little Sutton** where there is now a set of traffic lights, turning right into Ledsham Road. Walkers Lane is on the left of the photo by the light coloured car. This was named after the local chemist and photographer whose shop was situated at the corner C1932.



Below: The original village Inn stood opposite the Hooton Arms in Eastham. Pictured here in 1906 the Hooton Arms was once the school masters house and the school was the adjacent old barn with thatched roof and mud floor.

Above: Stanley Lane in **Eastham** at the turn of the century. Eastham village school is seen behind the four boys on the right. The other boys are sittingon a sandstone outcrop in front of Laurel Cottage. St. Mary's Church is sivuated to the right behind the sandstone wall.



The historic organ in a New Brighton church has recently been awarded Grade ll* listing by the British Institute of Organ Studies (BIOS). The organ of St James' church was listed by the BIOS due to its being "an instrument of importance to the national heritage and one deserving careful preservation for the benefit of future generations."

As well as being a fine and historic instrument, the St James' organ is highly unusual in that it is much older than the church itself! The organ was originally installed in the church of St John

Egremont in Wallasey when that church was built in 1833. St James' was not built until 1856. But after St John's was made redundant in 2004 its organ was transferred to St James' where it has since been used for many prestigious recitals and festivals.

Revd Heather Atkinson, the vicar of St James' New Brighton, said "The listing of our church's organ is a great honour, but also a responsibility. We will ensure it is lovingly maintained and used to enhance our worship and to bring the pleasure of organ music to a wider audience."

The sun is shining, birds are singing and it's time for your garden to come back from the winter weather. Your garden needs some help getting back in shape, though, so it's time to get the supplies from the garden centres, pull out the tools from the shed and get to work.

Here are some tips for your getting your spring garden green and beautiful by the time the season reaches its peak:

Clean out the garden

It's time to clean your garden and remove all the debris (leaves, leftover branches, etc.) Get rid of weeds, making sure that you get the roots so they won't grow back. This is also a good time to sharpen your garden tools, if needed, because you're going to require them for plant maintenance and soil care.

Revitalise the soil

Because your soil is likely dried out and packed after winter, it's time to add moisture. Add organic material like compost or manure. You might need to test the soil to see what nutrients it needs, so you give it the right mixture. You might also need to add more fertilizer to increase the health of the soil and increase the life of your plants.



Trim old plants

Plants that survived the winter will need to be pruned so they'll grow anew in the spring. Make sure to wait until mid-April or May in case there's an unexpected freeze. Blooming plants should be pruned right after they bloom to avoid cutting off future flowers. Summer plants should be pruned in early spring.

Add mulch

In addition to fertilizers and organic materials, you should think about adding mulch to your flower beds and garden. One to three inches of mulch helps to prevent weeds and diseases. It also keeps the moisture in the garden and maintains the temperature. The rule of thumb is to keep the mulch a few inches from the plant stems to prevent roots from rotting.

Plant new flowers and shrubs

Once you've gotten the garden in shape and handled all of the old plants, it's time to turn your attention to new plants. Some recommendations for good spring plants include:

Pansies

Snapdragons

Vegetables like lettuce, peas and arugula - (rocket) Redbuds

Transplanting tomato plants from indoor pots to outside Lilacs

Tulips

You should lean towards planting more perennials rather than annuals, because annuals have to be replaced every year. This means you're making an investment in plants that will die every year and require replacement. Perennials, on the other hand, last for two to three years and usually survive winter frosts.

What to do for the rest of Spring

Once your spring garden is up and running again, it's time to look to the future and decide what to do with your garden next. It will need some care so it stays colourful and beautiful throughout the season. Here are some quick tips for garden maintenance throughout the rest of the season:

Mid-Spring:

Consider new flower beds. Plant some hardy annuals. Transplant seeds. Mulch.

Late Spring:

Deadhead and remove bulbs. Prune flowering shrubs.





NHS Rainbow Badges launched at CWP



Cheshire and Wirral Partnership NHS Foundation Trust (CWP) has signed up to the national rainbow badge scheme to coincide with LGBT+ History Month, reinforcing the Trust's commitment to being a diverse and inclusive employer and care provider.

The Rainbow Badge Initiative, which originated at Evelina London Children's Hospital, aims to make a positive difference by promoting a message of inclusion. The badge is a simple, visual symbol identifying that, if an NHS staff member or volunteer is wearing one, they are a person who an LGBT+ person (or their friends or family members) can talk to about issues relating to sexuality and gender identity.

To support the initiative, CWP has launched a training programme to provide staff and volunteers wearing the badges with the knowledge and awareness to support LGBT+ people with any issues they may face. Philip Makin, Equality, Diversity & Inclusion Coordinator for CWP, said: "I'm delighted to say that CWP is signed up to the NHS Rainbow Badge Initiative. The badge is

a way for us at CWP to demonstrate that we are aware of the issues LGBT+ people can face when accessing our services and also as staff and volunteers. It shows that the wearer is there to listen without judgement and signpost to further support if needed."

To receive their badge, CWP staff are required to complete the online training and give their own pledge.

Chief executive Sheena Cumiskey said: "It's been fantastic to see how many people have already signed up to be a badge wearer. Our staff's enthusiasm for the initiative continues to demonstrate that we take Equality, Diversity & Inclusion seriously in helping people to be the best they can be."

Heat oven to 400 F.

Place asparagus on sheet pan in one layer and drizzle with olive oil. Season with salt and pepper. Roast 15-20 minutes. Sprinkle with parsley mixture and place back in oven for 3-5 minutes.

Bridge Community Farms, based in Mill Lane, off Overpool Road, in Ellesmere Port, is looking for more people who can offer their time and expertise, help with sponsorship of their Better Lives Veg Boxes or can offer financial support for a young person on a work placement or for a Better Lives Veg Box to be delivered to a homeless charity.

They also need more delivery drivers who can work 8.30am-11.30am every Tuesday, café staff and volunteers who can help man their various market stalls across the region. Expenses are paid to all volunteers.

The charity offers training and life skills to children and young people who are struggling to thrive in a standard academic environment while ongoing guidance, support and work experience is also available to the unemployed.

The charity also runs weekly Bright Life groups to reduce social isolation in the community including a weekly crafts session every Thursday 12-2pm (cost £2.50) and a weekly woodworking group every Thursday 12-3pm (cost £3.50).
