

# SHORTHE MONTH OF FERDILARY

This feature each month will give true interesting facts from years gone by. See what you remember that happened in your lifetime.

### THIS DAY IN HISTORY FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY



#### **FEBRUARY 1**

Sixteen minutes before it was scheduled to land, the Space Shuttle Columbia broke apart in flight over west Texas, killing all seven crew members. The accident may have resulted from damage caused during liftoff when a piece of insulating foam from the external fuel tank broke off, piercing a hole in the shuttle's left wing that allowed hot gases to penetrate the wing upon reentry into the Earth's atmosphere. This was the second space shuttle lost in flight. After the disaster, Space Shuttle flight operations were suspended for more than two years. Construction of the International Space Station (ISS) was also put on hold.

#### **FEBRUARY 4 1926**

Malcolm Campbell sets a new world land speed record of 174 mph (278 kmph) at Pendine Sands in Wales in the Napier-Campbell Blue Bird. Malcolm astonishingly broke the land speed record 9 times between 1924 and 1935. setting the benchmark very high for his son Donald. He became an icon in the public eye with his daredevil image and the sleek futuristic cars, all of which he named 'Blue Bird'. He also broke the water speed record 4 times in speedboats he also called Blue Bird!



#### **FEBRUARY 9 1964**

73 million Americans tuned into the 'Ed Sullivan Show' to watch four lads from Liverpool appear for the first time. The Beatles broke viewing records with their appearance, it is still supposed to be one of the largest viewing audiences ever in America.

The boys think that one of the big things that broke them was the hairdo more than the music to start with. American fathers reportedly told their children they were wearing wigs.

A lot of fathers wanted the television turned off but a lot of mothers and children made them keep it on!





#### **JANUARY 15 1971**

Tanners, bobs and half-crowns all disappeared as Britain went decimal. The massive change had taken the Decimal Currency Board five years to plan.

Thanks to a three year education campaign, including a tv drama called 'Granny Gets the Point', free readyreckoners and rudimentary conversion calculators, fears of galloping inflation, crafty retailers rounding up prices or public rejection never came to pass and the transition was hailed a success.

**FEBRUARY 6 1952** - King George VI died. His daughter Princess Elizabeth became Queen Elizabeth II, her actual coronation took place on June 2 1953.

**FEBRUARY 11 1975** - The Iron Lady, Margaret Thatcher became the first woman leader of the Conservative Party. She became Prime Minister in May 1979 and held office until November 1990.

**FEBRUARY 7 1812** - Novelist Charles Dickens was born in Portsmouth. He examined social inequalities through his works including; David Copperfield, Oliver Twist, and Nicholas Nickleby. In 1843, he wrote A Christmas Carol in just a few weeks, an enormously popular work even today.

**FEBRUARY 27 1991 - Desert Storm, the 100 hour ground war ended as Allied troops entered Kuwait just four days after launching their offensive against Saddam Hussein's Iraqi forces.**

### Ford EcoSport 1.0L EcoBoost 125PS 6 Speed



The Ford EcoSport has been around for a while now. My friend owns one and is very happy with it. So are his wife and the whole family. Now, I'm going, to be honest, I'm not a fan of its looks. Do I think Ford could have done a better job? Yes – basically. But hey, a car is a car. Also, for most, the family car is a functional item for getting from A – B. All the same, the EcoSport is a vehicle that you can load up to the hilt with gear - and is ideal for all those camping trips away or carrying your mountain bike. Joking aside, The Ford EcoSport is a pretty good

all-round vehicle and many people will be very happy after purchase. Also, there are some pretty good deals around for the Titanium version at the moment so shop around.

#### **On the Road**

Into the corners, the chassis felt poised and tight, even when dealing with all the potholes and bumps on some of our worst roads here in Staffordshire.

(take note – Staffordshire County Council, please repair the large hole at the junction just at the end of my road – it's only been there since September 2020) Plus when the tarmac gets twisty, the EcoSport's chassis firms up to give you maximum grip in and out of every corner. The steering also feels light, direct and is perfectly balanced with plenty of feedback on what the road beneath you is doing. Also, doing 70mph on the motorway - its all silent and feels quiet and relaxed. Ford has put in a lot of effort into making the cabin as quiet as it can be, and it shows.

#### **Power and Efficiency**

The EcoSport I had on test was powered by a 1.0-litre petrol engine that has a 0-62 time of around 11.0 seconds and a top speed of 111mph. Fuel consumption is also good, giving a combined figure of around 47 mpg. Being an EcoBoost engine, it has lots of get up and go.

So, firstly, how well does it get a move on? Well, basically, pretty good if I'm being honest and the engine is quite refined thanks to clever EcoBoost technology. Also, its torque band is not bad 170Nm (200Nm with overboost) You also get a wonderful 6-speed gearbox that's 'smooth' and slick. You are never going to break The World Speed Record or take on anyone from the lights because the point of the EcoSport is to be functional and fun. This is something it has by the bucket load. I like the EcoSport because its practical for a family and its fun to drive. It also has bags of torque and plenty of space on the inside.



#### **Interior & Technology**

First off, in Titanium trim – the EcoSport is not lacking in technology or comfort. For a start, the seats are 'well lush' and the interior space is good for a large family. There is also plenty of space in the rear for adults and even people over 6ft can slip in easily.

On the inside; there's also plenty of standard equipment, such as; 17" 10-spoke premium Shadow Silver machined alloy wheels, Automatic headlights, Power-foldable door mirrors with puddle lights, Silver-finish roof rails, Rain-sensing wipers, Partial Sensico seat trim, Centre console with armrest and openable stowage, Cruise control with Adjustable Speed Limiter, Ford SYNC 3 Navigation with 8" Touchscreen, DAB Radio, Emergency Assistance, Apple CarPlay & Android Auto, USB connectivity, 7-speakers and FordPass Connect (Embedded Modem) 4.2" colour cluster display, Auto-dimming rear-view mirror, Rear View Camera with rear parking distance sensors, Electricallyoperated front and rear windows with global opening/closing, Ambient lighting, Front door threshold plates with EcoSport logo and Electronic Automatic Temperature Control (EATC).

Space inside the boot is also very good easily managing to fit in all the family luggage. Also, if you are looking to own the EcoSport to move stuff around – then it's pretty good at doing that as well.

Above: Looking along Chester Road, Little Sutton where there is now a set of traffic lights, turning right into Ledsham Road. Walkers Lane is on the left of the photo by the light coloured car. This was named after the local chemist and photographer whose shop was situated at the corner C1932.

Left: 1834. **Eastham** windmill was originally sited in Carlett Park but in 1834 it was taken down and moved to the Chester side of Eastham Village. One of the sails was blown off during a gale in the last century so the miller removed the opposite sail. This worked well until a storm in 1895 blew the remaining two sails down, and the miller used them to repair his other mill at Willaston. This photograph shows how the mill looked without any sails at the turn of the century. This mill was demolished in the 1930s. In 1932 a transport cafe was built on the site adjoining the mill by Cartwright Bros. This was later to become The Little Chef in the 1970s.

Today it is better known as Starbucks on A41.

Below: This vessel, the Guiding Star, is pictured stranded at **Thurstaston Beach** on 18th February 1913.



Left 1905. Leasowe was a popular site for camping with the tents in front of Leasowe Lighthouse. It was not only popular with the general public but also the military in the form of the territorials who also used this area. However, the pond in the foreground is an indication that this was a low lying area and prone to flooding.

Below 1918. The Coachman's Cottage on the right, in White Row Cottages Village Road Bromborough, was the home of chauffeur to Bromborough Hall Robert Loadman. The two cars on the left are parked outside the Royal Oak - the two farm buildings in front and to the left of St. Barnabas's Church spire belonged to Tellett's Farm. Chester Road was to the right of the seat with the lamp on top.





#### **Bacon-Apple Red Cabbage Soup**

Prep time:15 mins, Cook time:20 mins, Servings: 4

- 2 slices thick-cut bacon, chopped 1 medium red onion, chopped
- (about 1/2 cup)
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- 1 jar (16 ounces) Sweet & Sour Red Cabbage, not drained

- 1 cup chopped onion
- 1 cup chopped red bell pepper
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 2 cans (15 ounces each) READ German Potato Salad, chopped
- 1 bottle (12 ounces) light beer 3/4 cup reduced-sodium, fat-free chicken broth
- 6 ounces (1 cup) diced ham, smoked turkey or sliced smoked sausage (optional)
- 1/2 teaspoon salt (optional)
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
  - 1 tablespoon chopped parsley rye croutons (optional) crumbled bacon (optional)

In Dutch oven or 3-quart saucepan over medium heat, cook onion and bell pepper in oil until onion starts to brown, 5-7 minutes, stirring occasionally. Add potato salad, beer, broth and meat, if desired, and stir to combine.

Continue simmering about 3-5 minutes, until apples are tender and soup reaches desired consistency.

Spoon into bowl. Garnish with apples, yogurt and crumbled bacon, if desired.



Bring to boil, reduce heat and simmer, uncovered, 10 minutes, stirring occasionally. Add salt, if desired, pepper and parsley.

Serve topped with rye croutons and bacon, if desired.

# What's Appening at Chester Zoo.

# Some of the world's smallest monkeys born at Chester Zoo

- Twin pygmy marmosets arrive to parents Zoe and Baldrick
- Miniature infants born measuring just two inches and weighing 10 grams
- Tiny primates spotted taking a ride on the backs of other family members
- Species is threatened in its native South America home from habitat destruction and hunting



Big news about two tiny baby monkeys! Twin pygmy marmosets hitch a ride with dad Baldrick at Chester Zoo

# Some of the world's smallest species of monkey has been born at Chester Zoo.

The pair of eastern pygmy marmosets, one of the most miniature primate species on Earth, arrived to parents Zoe (3) and Baldrick (4).

The tiny twins each measure just two inches (five centimetres) in length and weigh no more than 10 grams.

Keepers say the babies are already "highly inquisitive" but are so small that it will be some time yet until their genders are known.

Holly Webb, a Primate Keeper at Chester Zoo, said:

"It's wonderful to see new additions within the marmoset family and it's almost unbelievable just how small the babies are when they are first born. They are no bigger than a ping pong ball!



"Mum Zoe and dad Baldrick have jumped straight into parenthood. Zoe is ever so caring and, unlike other primates, dad is heavily involved in the upbringing of the youngsters. Baldrick sensed that Zoe was ready to give birth and even put on a little extra weight to give him the energy to care for the twins. He's really got stuck into the parenting - we spotted him carrying the babies around on his back when they were just one day old.

"New babies always strengthen family bonds and some of the younger primates in the group have also been carrying the new arrivals around. It's great to see them learn and pick up parenting tips from Zoe and Baldrick, and that experience will be important if they one day go on to have young of their own. The fact that younger members of the family are trusted to carry around such delicate new-borns, builds a lot of trust within the group.

"The babies are already very inquisitive and aware of their surroundings. I can't wait to see them develop their own little personalities."

The eastern pygmy marmoset is native to the rainforests of western Brazil, southeastern Colombia, eastern Ecuador and eastern Peru. These miniature monkeys are threatened by habitat loss and often exposed to hunting or their capture for the pet trade.

Dr Nick Davis, Deputy Curator of Mammals at the zoo, said:

"Many primate species around the world are highly threatened, often due to largescale habitat destruction, hunting and the illegal wildlife trade. Sadly, this is very much the case for the eastern pygmy marmoset.

"Despite their tiny stature, pygmy marmosets make a lot of loud noises, especially when calling out to attract a mate or warning others of danger. Even though they are the world's most miniature species of monkey, their whistles and squeals can be heard throughout the rainforest. Unfortunately, as their forest homes continue to disappear, this can be to their detriment, as a lack of cover leaves them even more exposed to illegal hunters and trappers. Thankfully, conservation teams are working hard to restore forest and create safe areas while new arrivals at the zoo help us to further highlight what needs to be done to prevent their extinction."



Pygmy marmosets are social animals, have one mate for life and their tails are longer than their bodies, which helps keep them balanced as they pass from branch to branch through the forest. They grow to around eight inches long and just 130g.

The word marmoset originates from the French word "marmouset" which means shrimp and their gestation period is around four-and-a-half months. The species has specialised diet which includes insects, fruit and tree sap.
