HISTORY

This feature each month will give interesting facts from years gone by. See what you remember that happened in your lifetime.

THIS DAY IN HISTORY FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER



1st December 1990

England was connected to mainland Europe for the first time since the Ice Age as engineers drilled through the final wall of rock to join the two halves of the Channel Tunnel and link Britain to France. To a multitude of cheers, the workers celebrated with champagne - the only time alcohol has been allowed underground on the

work site. The first Britons walked through the tunnel to have their passports stamped in France. There were similar scenes on the other side as a French party which drove into Folkestone, Kent, headed straight over to customs and immigration officers.

10th December 1901.

The first Nobel Peace Prizes were awarded worth \$30,000 each. Alfred Nobel, a Swedish chemist, had died five years earlier leaving the fortune he had amassed from his invention dynamite, to the awarding foundation.

In his last will and testament, he wrote that much of his fortune was to be used to give prizes to those who have done their best for humanity in the field of physics, chemistry, physiology or medicine, literature and peace.

Not everybody was pleased with this. His will was opposed by his relatives and questioned by authorities in various countries. It took four years for his executors to convince all parties to follow Alfred's wishes.





21st December 1988


Regulary scheduled Pan Am flight 103, was a jumbo jet bound for New York. While the aircraft was in flight over the Scottish town of Lockerbie, it was destroyed by a bomb that had been planted on board, killing all 243 passengers and 16 crew in what became known as the Lockerbie bombing.Large sections of the aircraft crashed in a residential street in Lockerbie, killing 11 residents. With a total of 270 fatalities, it is the deadliest terrorist attack in the history of the United Kingdom.



28th December 1918

In 1918 the Representation of the People Act was passed which allowed women over the age of 30 who met a property qualification to vote. Although 8.5 million women met this criteria, it was only about two-thirds of the total population of women in the UK.

The same Act abolished property and other restrictions for men, and extended the vote to virtually all men over the age of 21. Additionally, men in the armed forces could vote from the age of 19. The electorate increased from eight to 21 million, but there was still huge inequality between women and men.






BOOK REVIEW : MAKING IT - How I repaired my Life by Jay Blades (host of The Repair Shop)

A major issue facing many people both during and following the lockdowns of the pandemic has been how to pursue a more rewarding and worthwhile lifestyle emotionally, socially and financially.

For many the isolation from friends, family and social groups has increased their difficulties in coping with personal struggles. In an absorbing, inspirational book, Jay Blades in "Making It" takes the reader on a meaningful, thought provoking and at times emotionally stirring personal reflection of his 'chequered lifestyle'. He engages readers with a frank and open insight



of his personal strengths and weaknesses during his life's journey from Hackney where the innocence was 'beaten out of him' as he was bullied and beaten up. His life was full of conflict including a beating from the police because of the colour of his skin.

Readers familiar with Jay's presentation skills can assimilate his recall of his experiences in life in the text. His emotional detachment from his "absent father", bullying and racism at secondary school, his range of work, his encounters with physical violence, his gift of the gab, wandering eye for the ladies and other experiences leading to being homeless with no purpose in life.

His personal philosophy that "with care and love anything can be mended" is a key theme of the free flowing text. Jay does not bemoan his hardships as a child but terms his experiences "the time of his life". He has great praise for the positive influences of his mother, his maternal grandmother in Barbados, and in particular his mother's boyfriend Lloyd Macfarlane. It was Lloyd, the male role model he desperately sought, who extended his positive experiences and had a profound impact on him. These positive influences enabled him to have the base to overcome the demons in his lifestyle and to blossom, initially as a person and later as a television star.

His experiences as a young man illustrate clearly his vulnerability, even when he became a Dad with his partner Marie. By the age of 21 he was living in the Salvation Army hostel in the Elephant and Castle in London. His experiences may well resonate with readers, either personally or by their awareness of young people who 'have lost their way in life'. It was a privilege to read the details of the influence that a "kind hearted guy" Michael Arlington had on Jay by changing his pathway in life by getting him to work as a volunteer with the Cyrenians. Readers will gain greatly from the recollections of Jay on the influence on his life of the new "positive experiences" as he puts his vast personal strengths to good use in helping the homeless and uncared for. It is an inspiring and emotional journey as Jay eventually blossoms as a truly positive personality as a television star.

I am certain that many readers will be familiar with Jay's outstanding contribution as the presenter of "The Repair Shop" (BBC). In the programme he co-ordinates the work of a team of expert crafts people as they work to restore viewers treasured "family heirlooms" which have seen "better days". A key feature of the programme is Jay's positive pragmatism, kindness and ability to empathise and connect with the individual or family seeking 'expert help' to repair an object which has a 'significant meaning or memory' within their lives. As he comments in the introduction of the book, "I'm the jovial geezer in the flat cap who greets nervous visitors", without fully acknowledging his role as the generator of warmth and positive empathy.

Within his other TV programme, Jay's Yorkshire Workshop, Jay demonstrates his personal awareness and gratitude for the support he received from others in the community to turn his own life around. Jay and his team 'give back' by paying tribute to the work of unsung heroes within the community. For instance, in a recent programme his team re-made a rocking horse for a couple who had fostered over 130 children. The programme generates real life experiences focused on wonderful family reflections that trigger treasured and precious memories linked to an object that needs careful repairing. It frequently results emotional floods of tears for visitors and members of the repair team as the repaired artefacts are unveiled.

This is an enthralling story of the real life journey of a boy from the tough streets of Hackney, who faced emotional difficulties, vulnerability, and personal difficulties including a mental health breakdown. Undoubtedly, the support of his mother and significant others enabled his personal strengths including kindness, warmth, determination and tenacity to enable him to conquer his frustrations and blossom as a positive influence on others. As Jay emphases, with care and love anything can be mended. A truly beneficial book which will be a great boost for readers of all age as they re-engage with their lives and communities.

Mental Health Organisation invests in Cutting-Edge Tech to improve Overall Service

New parks and dockside walkways being delivered along Northbank at Wirral Waters

Parks, green spaces, dockside walkways and cycle routes are transforming the Northbank waterfront at Wirral Waters, sitting alongside the new homes now arriving onsite.

Extensive public realm infrastructure work began on site earlier this year, following the appointment of contractor Eric Wright Civil Engineering (EWCE) by Peel L&P.





Large sections of a new dock edge walkway are now complete, ultimately opening up public access to the dockside of East Float for the first time in over a century. This 'upper boardwalk' pedestrian and cycleway link will create an attractive thoroughfare for residents alongside the water's edge.

The first of two small residential parks, which have been designed to create green open spaces at the heart of this new mixed neighbourhood, is also shortly to complete. The parks are adjacent to the very first residential developments at Wirral Waters, the 500 home Legacy project due on site shortly, and East Float, a joint venture between Peel L&P and House by Urban Splash.

A series of four contemporary squares, currently under construction, will connect the Dock Road pedestrian and cycleway public realm works through to the dock edge, improving connectivity.

The new neighbourhood being created at Northbank has been designed to facilitate an open, mixed and connected community, which improves the health and wellbeing of existing and new residents and encourages active travel.

EWCE were also responsible for the public realm improvement works which took place earlier this year to the walking and cycling route that marks the boundary of the Northbank neighbourhood. This included the construction of 590 metres of shared cycleway and footpath next to the A5139 Dock Road, between East Float Apartments and Duke Street, as well as landscaping, street trees, boundary treatments, new street lighting columns and digital infrastructure.

The public realm works have been assisted by a £6m grant awarded in the Autumn of 2019 from Homes England's Housing Infrastructure Fund (HIF) to Peel L&P. The grant, which is one of the biggest HIF grants to be awarded in the North West, has helped fund essential remediation, infrastructure and public realm works at Wirral Waters, including cycling and pedestrian routes, to support over 1,000 new homes being delivered across the Northbank neighbourhood.

Sophie White, Director of Infrastructure Grants at Homes England, said: "We are committed to working with ambitious local authority partners seeking to meet their local housing needs through delivery of key infrastructure. This £6m funding from the Housing Infrastructure Fund will help to fund essential infrastructure works at Wirral Waters, including green transport routes, and support the creation of new homes in the area."

Richard Mawdsley, Director of Development at Wirral Waters, also commented: "At Northbank we are creating a neighbourhood with community, green public spaces and connectivity embedded in its foundations so that it becomes a place that enhances the quality of people's lives.

"This is the first residential development we are delivering at Wirral Waters and you can now see it coming together on the ground. It's already becoming a great place to walk and cycle and it's exciting to see that life is beginning to return to this traditional dockland area once again."

Alan Evans, Director of Regeneration and Place at Wirral Council, said: "It's incredibly exciting to see this area developing, making a tangible difference to the lives of our residents and businesses. Working with our partners across the Liverpool City Region, Homes England, Peel L&P, and the Council, we are starting to deliver real transformation in this area across the infrastructure, the buildings and public space.



"Providing active travel options and high quality green spaces for our residents is an essential part of our regeneration programme and it is fantastic to see this being demonstrated in the new neighbourhood at Northbank."






